- 4. The Committee heard reservations and point of view of Senator Dr. Jehanzeb Jamaldini and the response of the MoS for Information Technology and Telecommunication in detail. The Committee members were of the view that the mobile phone service is a basic need of every individual as it is the only possible way for communication at a short span of time as well as feasible economically, hence, it should be provided to each and every part of the country on priority basis.
- 5. After detailed deliberations, the Committee disposed of the issue with the following recommendations / directions:-
 - M/o Information Technology and Telecommunication in coordination with USF and PTA should ensure to take immediate steps to provide cellular services in the areas of Awaran, Khuzdar, Lasbela, Kohlu Chaghai, Dalbadin, Jhal Magsi especially all those areas of the Province of Balochistan where no security, law & order situation prevails and report the update progress in the matter, to the Committee, at the earliest.
 - In order to enable the residents of Province of Balochistan to avail information and communication technology, the Universal Services Fund (USF) should conduct a survey of the Province of Balochistan, particularly of un-served and under-served areas of that province to develop and promote telecommunication services, at the earliest.
