2. The composition of the Committee on National Food Security & Research is as under:-



3. The latest position in relation to the 1400 acres NARC/PARC land is reported to be in possession with the PARC.

4. The case was fixed in the Supreme Court of Pakistan on 23<sup>rd</sup> November, 2016 where the Additional Attorney General of the Government of Pakistan informed the Hon'ble Court that the matter has been referred to the Cabinet in accordance with the ruling given by the Supreme Court and he requested for an adjournment so as to enable the Cabinet to give its views. The Hon'ble Supreme Court was pleased to grant an adjournment of four (4) weeks.

5. As such one has to wait for the decision of the Cabinet where after, the matter would be placed for a decision by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of Pakistan.

6. The report is submitted before the House as per directions of the Chairman Senate.
