REPORT OF THE STANDING COMMITTEE ON INTERIOR AND NARCOTICS CONTROL ON MURDER CASE OF PROF.DR.SHAHID NAWAZ, CARDIOLOGIST OF PIMS

I, Chairman of the Standing Committee on Interior and Narcotics Control, have the honour to present the report "Murder case of prof. Dr.Shahid Nawaz, Cardiologist of PIMS" moved by Senator Lt. General (R) Abdul Qayyum on 15th June, 2016 and referred to the Standing Committee on Interior and Narcotics Control for consideration and report thereof.

- 3. The matter was taken up in the meetings of the Standing Committee held on 14.07.2016, 23.08.2016, 19.10.2016, 08.11.2016 and 14.12.2016.
- 4. The Committee in its successive meetings discussed the case, gave patient hearings to the plaintiff and directed the authority to judiciously investigate the matter. The Committee unanimously condemned the brutal killing of renowned Cardiologist, Dr.Shahid Nawaz Malik of PIMS on 14th February, 2015 in broad day light at the PIMS premises. The Committee directed the Secretary Interior to investigate the murder case of Dr.Shahid Nawaz Malik and submit a report to that effect. Also it was directed that a Joint Investigation Team (JIT) be constituted with an officer of good repute. Besides this the members of the bereaved family may nominate one member. PIMS authorities should assist the team with expertise in the field of medico-legal

as well as provide evidence gathered from the site of offence. The victim family must be kept informed about the developments.

5. The Committee disposed of the matter on 14th December, 2016 in an in-camera briefing by the Police, in which following members of the Committee attended the meeting.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Committee recommended that as per briefing in the said meeting the investigation should proceed on the five leads as discussed in the Committee meeting. Being a sensitive investigative process the details of the five leads were kept secret. However the Committee directed that the investigation be completed within six weeks' time and challan be presented to the Court. However, the Committee observed that in case of failure on the part of Police, the plaintiff has right to inform the Committee regarding inconvenience caused because of the Police behavior. The Committee disposed of the matter and report is submitted to the House.
