2. **SENATOR SIRAJUL HAQ** to move that the Bill further to amend the Pakistan Penal Code, 1860 [The Pakistan Penal Code (Amendment) Bill, 2017] (**Amendment of sections 292, 293 and 294**), as reported by the Standing Committee, be taken into consideration, at once.

3. **SENATOR SIRAJUL HAQ** to move that the Bill further to amend the Pakistan Penal Code, 1860 [The Pakistan Penal Code (Amendment) Bill, 2017] be passed.

"The Senate of Pakistan is of the opinion that conversion of National Highway from Karachi to Hyderabad into motorway will create many problems and hardships for light traffic as it will not be able to handle all traffic, the heavy as well as light traffic.

The House recommends that the Government should construct a separate motorway to connect Karachi with other parts of the country."

20. SENATOR COL. (R) SYED TAHIR HUSSAIN MASHHADI to move the following resolution:-

"This House recommends that the Government should take necessary steps to improve the performance of the Pakistan Cotton Standard Institute, Karachi."

21. SENATOR MUHAMMAD USMAN KHAN KAKAR to move the following resolution:-

"This House recommends that three different slabs be made for tariff of natural gas in Balochistan for domestic consumers i.e. from 0 to 500 mcf, 501 to 1000 mcf and 1001 mcf and above."
