AMENDMENT OF SENATE RULES

(Under Rule 242)

3. MR. MUHAMMAD RAZA HAYAT HARRAJ, Minister of State for Parliamentary Affairs to seek leave under sub-rule (3) of rule 242 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the Senate, 1988, to move the following amendment:-

"that in Chapter V, the existing rule 19 shall be re-numbered as rule 19A and before rule 19A re-numbered as aforesaid, the following new rule shall be inserted, namely:-

- 19. <u>Calendar of business for the year</u> .- (1) At the commencement of the first session of each year, the Government shall provide to the Chairman a provisional calendar of sessions for the parliamentary year.
- (2) The Chairman shall, in consultation with the Leader of the House and Leaders of the Parties, cause the provisional calendar to be circulated amongst the members forthwith.

(3) The President on the advice of the Prime Minister shall summon the Senate to meet, as far as practical, on the dates mentioned in that provisional calendar:

Provided that the President may, if so, advised by the Prime Minister, summon the Senate to meet on a date different from that mentioned in the provisional calendar and intimation thereof shall be given to the Leader of the House as soon as practicable.

- (4) Nothing contained in this rule shall limit the power of the Chairman to summon a requisitioned session of the Senate to meet at any time in accordance with the Constitution.".
- 4. MR. MUHAMMAD RAZA HAYAT HARRAJ, Minister of State for Parliamentary Affairs to move under sub-rule (4) of rule 242 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the Senate, 1988, that the proposed amendment in the said Rules be taken into consideration.
