- 6. The Committee considered The Starred Question No. 172 regarding "The amount allocated and released for Frontier Constabulary (FC) Khyber Pakhtunkhwa during the current fiscal years with head wise break up" raised by Senator Bahramand Khan Tangi in the House on 7<sup>th</sup> May, 2019.
- 7. Senator Bahramand Khan Tangi, Mover briefed the Committee on the Starred Question No. 172 regarding "The amount allocated and released for Frontier Constabulary (FC) Khyber Pakhtunkhwa during the current fiscal years with head wise break up" raised by Senator Bahramand Khan Tangi in the House on 7<sup>th</sup> May, 2019.
- 8. The Committee was also informed that 1597 FC personnel have not been paid salaries for the last 03 months for which additional PKR 1000 Million are to be arranged by the government. It was further informed that 75 Platoons were to be raised but due to financial constraints only 35 Platoons could have been raised so far.
- 9. The Chairman Committee appreciated the FC for their excellence services being rendered despite of meagre resources.
- 10. The Chairman Committee directed that the Government should provide additional amount of Rs.1000 Million for payment of salaries within 04 weeks.
- 11. The Chairman Committee directed the Ministry of Interior to send a letter to Ministry of Finance to provide required funds to the FC.
- 12. The Chairman stated that FC, KPK sacrifices and efforts in marinating peace are highly commendable and it is unfair that their personnel are not getting their due salaries.

13. After a detailed discussion The Chairman Committee disposed of the matter.
