17. SENATOR ENGR. RUKHSANA ZUBERI to move that this House may discuss the issue of non-payment or curtailed payment of Pension and salaries.

18. SENATOR MUSHTAQ AHMED to move that this House may discuss the issue of non-functioning of National Commission for Human Rights for the last six months with particular reference to increasing sexual offences against children.

19. SENATORS MUHAMMAD USMAN KHAN KAKAR, GUL BASHRA AND ABIDA MUHAMMAD AZEEM to move that this House may discuss the original idea, purpose and implementation status of Aghaz-e-Haqooq-e-Balochistan package.

20. SENATOR GIANCHAND to move that this House may discuss the losses including the losses of human lives in the country due to recent heavy rains, snowfalls and avalanches and post relief activities initiated by the Government in the affected areas.

21. SENATOR MIR KABEER AHMED MUHAMMAD SHAHI to move that this House may discuss the issue of Reko Diq with particular reference to the situation after the imposition of \$5.976 billion penalty by the International Center for Settlement of Investment Disputes (ICSID) against Pakistan.

DEFERRED RESOLUTION

22. SENATOR MIAN MUHAMMAD ATEEQ SHAIKH to move the following resolution:-

"This House recommends that the Government should introduce a Group Insurance Scheme for its Employees, whereby Federal Government Servants shall be entitled to get the insured amount at the time of retirement out of their Group Insurance Fund, on the analogy of the Provincial Government employees."

RESOLUTIONS

23. SENATOR SIRAJUL HAQ to move the following resolution:-

"This House recommends that the Government should establish regular crossing point at Pak-Afghan border in the area of Kharki, Shahi bin Shahi, district Lower Dir for cross border movement of the people."

24. SENATOR ENGR. RUKHSANA ZUBERI to move the following resolution:-

"This House recommends to the Government to formulate a support structure for kidnapped and missing individuals."

25. SENATOR SIRAJUL HAQ to move the following resolution:-

"This House recommends that the Government should take necessary steps to fix the minimum wage for labourers @ Rs. 30,000/ p.m., increase the pension of labourers @ 100%, ensure the timely payment of death grant, marriage grant, educational stipends to the labourers and their children out of the workers welfare fund and prohibit the transfer of money from the said fund to other heads/sectors."

26. SENATOR ABDUL REHMAN MALIK to move the following resolution:-

"This House salutes the people of Kashmir who have sacrificed their lives for their right of self determination.

The House also pays tribute to the security forces of the country for sacrificing their lives to protect the LoC against the Indian aggression.

The House recommends that the Government should:

- i) move a Resolution in the United Nations Security Council (UNSC) asking for fixing the date of plebiscite in Jammu and Kashmir for the self determination of Kashmiri people as per the UNSC decision and the Karachi Agreement of 1949 which shall be supervised by the Truce Sub-Committee to be constituted under the said Agreement;

- ii) Should ask the International Human Rights Commission, Geneva to send a high powered delegation to investigate the recent human rights violations in Indian Occupies Kashmir during the curfew continuously for more than 100 days;
- iii) should appoint a high powered delegation to go to the OIC to ask it to play its role for the protection of oppressed Kashmiri people.”

27. SENATOR SIRAJUL HAQ to move the following resolution:-

“This House expresses its concern over the non-fulfillment of the pledges made to the people of erstwhile FATA at the time of its merger with Khyber Pakhtunkhwa;

The House also deplores the non-implementation of the Rs.100 billion annual development package and provision of employment to the youth of the erstwhile FATA;

The House, therefore urges upon the Government to take necessary steps for the fulfillment of all the pledges made with the people of those areas with particular reference to release and make plan for utilization of the Rs. 100 billion package, development of infrastructure, establishment of the Universities, provision of employment to the youth, electrification of the non-electrified areas, provision of uninterrupted electricity and establishment of regular crossing points on Pak-Afghan border for promotion of trade in those areas.”
