

RULING OF THE CHAIR

RESTRICTION ON DISCUSSION IN THE PARLIAMENT REGARDING THE CONDUCT OF JUDGES.

In terms of Article 68 of the Constitution of Pakistan, 1973, no discussion can take place on the conduct of any Judge of the Supreme Court or of a High Court in the discharge of his duties, however, only a fair comment can be made on the judgment. Members are advised to refrain from making any personal comments or casting reflections on the conduct of Judges of the superior courts. Remarks beyond the category of fair comments stand expunged.
