Questions Nos. 36, 37 and 44 were deferred. Remaining printed questions and their replies were treated as laid on the Table of the House.

### **CONSIDERATION OF ADMISSIBILITY OF ADJOURNMENT MOTIONS**

Admissibility of the following Adjournment Motions were determined:-

1. Senator Taj Haider moved Adj. Motion No. 1(1-273/2018-M), to discuss the situation arising out of violation of the agreement on post enumeration survey signed by Senate Parliamentary leaders and Statistics Division.

Motion was disposed off with the directions to Leader of the House and the Mover to meet and the Statistics Division to cancel the meeting scheduled on 16<sup>th</sup> of February.

2. Senator Sherry Rehman moved Adj. Motion No. 2(2-273/2018-M), to discuss the alleged highly critical level of PIA's safety Assessment of Foreign Aircraft (SAFA).

Motion was dropped due to absence of the Member.

**3. Senator Sehar Kamran moved Adj. Motion No. 3(3-273/2018-M),** to discuss the publishing of an advertisement called "Free Karachi" and running a campaign in this regard by a US Newspaper "Washington Times".

The matter was clubbed with a similar Calling Attention Notice to be discussed on 15<sup>th</sup> of February, 2018, therefore the Member did not press the Motion which was disposed of accordingly.

4. Senator Muhammad Ali Khan Saif on behalf of Senator Abdul Rehman Malik, Chairman, Standing Committee on Interior, moved under sub-rule (1) of rule 194 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the Senate, 2012, that the time for presentation of report of the Committee on the Bill further to amend the Police Act, 1861 [The Police (Amendment) Bill, 2017], introduced by Senator Mohammad Azam Khan Swati on 18th December, 2017, may be extended till 6th March, 2018.

The Motion was put to the House and requisite extension was granted.

5. SENATOR SYED MUZAFAR HUSSAIN SHAH, Convener, Special Committee on the performance of PIA, moved under sub-rule (1) of rule 194 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the Senate, 2012, that the time for presentation of report of the Special Committee on a point of public importance raised by Senator Nighat Mirza, on 13th December, 2017, regarding the timings and parking difficulties of routine daily flight PK-300 from Karachi to Islamabad and the problems being faced by the PIA employees working / posted in Saudi Arabia, may be extended till 6th March, 2018.

Senator Farhatulllah babar pointed out the issue regarding the placement of Pakistan on a global terrorist financing list put forward by the United States of America and Britain and co-sponsored by France and Germany ahead of a meeting of the Financial Action Task Force (FATF) on terrorist financing in Paris and its implications.

# Chairman directed the Minister for Foreign Affairs to appear before the House on 15<sup>th</sup> of February, 2018 and make a statement in this regard.

2. Senator Mukhtiar Ahmed Dhamrah @ Aajiz pointed out the erroneous replacement of the signboards along the Karachi Hyderabad Motorway.

### Chairman referred the matter to the Standing Committee concerned.

3. Senator Muhammad Ali Khan Saif pointed out the recent publishing of an article in the Times of India (TOI) which claimed a shift in China's stance with respect to CPEC in favor of India.

#### Chairman directed the Ministery concerned to respond in the ensuing session.

4. Senator Sehar Kamran pointed out the response by the Cabinet Division regarding a unanimously passed resolution, wherein the Cabinet Division requested the Senate to reconsider its Resolution.

5. Senator Dr. Jehanzeb Jamaldini pointed out the recent rise in accidents on the National Highway due to inaction of Highway Police in penalizing vehicles running without brake lights.
