### CONSIDERATION OF ADMISSIBILITY OF ADJOURNMENT MOTIONS

Admissibility of the following Adjournment Motions will be determined:-

1. Senator Sehar Kamran moved Adj. Motion No. 17-269/2017-M, to discuss the statement of Indian Air Force Chief made on 5th October, 2017, that Indian Air Force has the capability to strike nuclear sites in Pakistan and they are ready for a full spectrum operation.

## The Mover withdrew her motion to raise the issue through some other parliamentary tool.

2. Senators Mukhtiar Ahmed Dhamrah @ Aajiz and Sassui Palijo moved Adj. Motion No. 18-269/2017-M, to discuss the recent move of the Federal Government to delink petroleum and gas Authority from provincial oversight which is not only a direct violation of the Constitution but will also create trust deficit between the Centre and the Provinces.

### AMENDMENTS TO THE SENATE RULES

(Under Rule 278)

Senator Taj Haider on his behalf and on behalf of Senator Raja Muhammad Zafar-Ul-Haq, Leader of the House, sought leave under sub-rule (4) of rule 278 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the Senate, 2012, to move that in rule 100, in sub-rule (1), in paragraph (c), of the said Rules for the full stop occurring at the end, a colon shall be substituted and thereafter, the following new proviso shall be added, namely:-

"Provided that if the Committee has recommended that a particular Bill may not be passed by the Senate then the Member-in-Charge may only move the motion mentioned in paragraph (c)."

The Motion was put to the House and the leave was granted by the House.

Thereafter, Senator Taj Haider on his behalf and on behalf of Senator Raja Muhammad Zafar-Ul-Haq, Leader of the House, moved that the proposed amendments in rule 100 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the Senate, 2012, be taken into consideration.

The Amendments were considered by the House. Thereafter, Senator Taj Haider on his behalf and on behalf of Senator Raja Muhammad Zafar-Ul-Haq, Leader of the House, moved that the proposed amendments in rule 100 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the Senate, 2012, be adopted.

The Motion was put to the House and the amendments were adopted by the House.
