Senator Syed Muzaffar Hussain Shah on behalf of Senator Dr. Jehanzeb Jamaldini, Chairman, Committee on Rules of Procedure and Privileges, presented report of the Committee on the breach of privilege of the Senate by the Joint Secretary (Legal), Ministry of Interior, by obstructing the proceedings of the House by not providing reply to Senate starred question No. 7, asked by Senator Nisar Muhammad, regarding the compensation paid to the heirs of martyrs of Army Public School, Peshawar, which was set down for answering on 11th April, 2017.
- 2. Senator Syed Muzaffar Hussain Shah on behalf of Senator Dr. Jehanzeb Jamaldini, Chairman, Committee on Rules of Procedure and Privileges, presented report of the Committee on the breach of privilege of the Senate due to non-provision of reply to part (c) of starred question No. 23, asked by Senator Farhatullah Babar on 11th April, 2017, as well as missing of the same in the brief for the Minister.

CALLING ATTENTION NOTICE

Following Calling Attention Notices were taken up in the House:-

1. Senators Nauman Wazir Khattak and Mian Muhammad Ateeq Shaikh drew attention of the Minister for Water and Power towards the underutilization of power by the Province of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa as allocated by the National Power Control Centre (NPCC), the balance being drawn by DISCOs in Punjab and the failure of the Government to take any corrective measure to mitigate this issue despite its acceptance by the Ministry.

Mr. Abid Sher Ali, Minister of State for Water and Power made the statement. However, the matter was referred to the Standing Committee concerned with the direction to report back in 45 days.

Senator Mian Muhammad Ateeq Shaikh drew attention of the Minister for Defence towards the killing of innocent Pakistanis in the recent outbreak of violent firing on Line of Control by the Indian Forces.

Mr. Abid Sher Ali on behalf of the Minister for Defence made the statement wherein he stated that some classified information is yet to be collected from the concerned quarters. The Chairman took serious notice of withholding information from the Parliament and observed that nothing can be withheld from the Parliament. The Chairman directed that the information may be provided during the course of 263rd Session either in the Chairman's Chamber or the portion of this matter can be held in an in camera sitting. The Leader of the House assured that he will communicate the same to the Minister for Defence.
