Following Calling Attention Notices were taken up in the House:-

 Senators Muhammad Usman Khan Kakar, Sardar Muhammad Azam Khan Musakhel and Gul Bashra drew attention of the Minister for Interior and Narcotics Control towards the non-functioning of Passport Office established in Harnai, District Musakhel.

Minister of State for Interior made Narcotics Control made statement and the Calling Attention Notice was disposed of.

2. Senator Karim Ahmed Khawaja drew attention of the Minister for Interior and Narcotics Control towards the imposition of ban on foreign tourists to visit Gilgit Baltistan without getting NOC from the Ministry of Interior.

Minister of State for Interior made Narcotics Control made statement and the Calling Attention Notice was disposed of.

### **REPORT OF THE STANDING COMMITTEE - PRESENTATION OF:**

Senator Sajjad Hussain Turi, Chairman, Standing Committee on National Health Services, Regulations and Coordination, presented report of the Committee on the Bill to provide for the regulation of health care services in the public and private sectors, and to protect the rights of patients [The National Health Care Bill, 2017] introduced by Senator Mohammad Azam Khan Swati on 10th April, 2017.

Since, the Committee has recommended that the Member may withdraw his Bill as the Government is also bring a Bill on this issue, therefore, the Chairman took serious notice of such recommendations and observed that it is not the right of the Government to ask a Private Member to withdraw his Bill due to the reason that the Government is also bringing a Bill on the same issue. Chairman urged the Mover of the instant Bill to proceed further under the Rules.

### MOTION [Under Rule 194(1)]

**SENATOR Samina Abid on behalf of Senator NASREEN JALIL,** Chairperson, Functional Committee on Human Rights, moved under sub-rule (1) of rule 194 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the Senate, 2012, that the time for presentation of report of the Functional Committee on the Bill to provide for protection of rights of transgender persons and their welfare and for matters connected therewith and incidental thereto [The Transgender Persons (Protection of Rights) Bill, 2017], introduced by Senator Zaheer-ud-Din Babar Awan, on 9<sup>th</sup> January, 2017, may be extended for a further period of sixty working days with effect from 6<sup>th</sup> June, 2017.

The Motion was put to the House and then requisite extension was granted.
