# **CONSIDERATION OF ADMISSIBILITY OF ADJOURNMENT MOTION**

The admissibility of the following adjournment motions was determined in the House: -

 The adjournment motion to discuss the sectarian hatred being promoted through acts of racial profiling which may provide a fertile ground to the extremists Daesh group to spread its ideology in Pakistan by recruiting militants particularly in Punjab, notice given by Senator Sherry Rehman. The Mover advanced his arguments on the admissibility of the adjournment motion.

The adjournment motion was opposed by the Minster for Law and Justice.

After hearing the mover, the Chairman held the motion in order.

Since first adjournment motion was admitted, therefore, admissibility of following adjournment motion was deferred:-

## **CALLING ATTENTION NOTICES**
