Mr. Abul Fazal Rizvi, CEO, Sindh Engro Coal Mining Company, briefed the Committee about the steps taken by the company to save the local people from the environmental effects of the project. He said that in order to determine the impact on environment components including water, wind, soil, noise, etc., detailed assessment was reviewed and approved by the concerned provincial environmental protection agencies. He further said that all rules, regulations and standards to safeguard environment were strictly adhered to. He added that NOCs from the Sindh Environment Protection Agency (SEPA) was obtained for the Thar coal based Engro Powergen Thar Coal Power Project. He apprised the Committee about the initiatives taken by the company on account of Corporate Social Responsibilities (CSR) that included:-

i) Provision of accommodation to displaced people of Thar.

ii) Establishment of mother child clinics and 250-Bed Thar Foundation Hospital, Islamkot.

iii) Setting up of 24 primary schools.

- iv) Employment of local people in the project.
- v) Training and employment of thari female truck drivers.
- vi) Khushal Thar Technical Training Programm.

vii) Khushal Naari Programme.

- Villages Improvement Plan: provision of clean drinking water, street pavements, roads connectivity, street solar light system, parks, clean lavatories, good drainage/sanitation, etc.
- ii) Million-Tree Plantation project initiated for green Thar.

5. The Mover of the agenda item expressed his satisfaction on the briefing given by the CEO of the Sindh Engro Coal Mining Company and the matter was disposed of.
