Chairman Committee stated that a compliance report has been received from the Balochistan Police on the recommendations of the Committee on the point of public importance regarding arrest of students Quetta protesting against PMC Exams raised by Senators Kamran Murtaza and Sardar Muhammad Shafiq Tareen in the Senate. The Chairman Committee informed that this matter was discussed in its meeting held on 18<sup>th</sup> October, 2021 and the Inspector General of Police, Balochistan and other senior police officials attended the meeting. But, the Movers were absent from the meeting. The Committee, again, took up this matter on 19<sup>th</sup> November in presence of senior police officers except Inspector General Police of Balochistan. The Movers expressed their displeasure on the absence of the IG, however, the Committee held extensive discussion on the matter and made its recommendations to be implemented in letter and spirit. And on third time, the matter was brought on the agenda of the meeting held on 09<sup>th</sup> December, 2021but the movers and police officials could not attend the meeting due to non-availability of flight from Quetta to Islamabad.
- 6. Chairman Committee stated that the report received is according to the recommendations of the Committee and is quite satisfactory. The Chairman Committee directed to lay the report on the table for the information of all Members and further recommendations, if any.
- 7. Senators Samina Mumtaz Zehri, Fawzia Arshad and Rana Maqbool Ahmed stated that the Government of Balochistan should be asked to issue the directions to the I.G. Police, Baluchistan not to repeat such incident in future.

## RECOMMENDATIONS:-

- The Committee recommended that the Ministry of Interior should send directions to the Secretary Home Department and I.G. Police of Balochistan to avoid recurrence of such incidents in future.
- ii. The Committee, keeping in view the fresh report received from the Balochistan Police, expressed its satisfaction and unanimously disposed of the point of public importance regarding arrest of students in Quetta protesting against PMC Exams raised by Senators Kamran Murtaza and Sardar Muhammad Shafiq Tareen in the Senate.
- 8. Chairman Committee, in view of the above, disposed of the Point of Public Importance regarding "Arrest of students in Quetta against PMC Exams" raised by Senator Kamran Murtaza and Senator Sardar Muhammad Shafiq Tareen in the Senate Sitting held on 29<sup>th</sup> September, 2021.
