Subject: REPORT OF THE STANDING COMMITTEE ON HUMAN RIGHTS.

I, Chairman of the Standing Committee on Human Rights, have the honour to present this report on budgetary proposals relating to Public Sector Development Program (PSDP) for the Financial Year 2022-23 in terms of rule 166 (7) of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the Senate, 2012.

3. The Standing Committee on Human Rights considered the matter in its meeting held on 25-02-2022 under my Chairmanship, which was attended by the following hon'ble Members:-

The Committee extensively considered the budgetary proposals relating to PSDP 2022-23 as aforesaid, prepared by the Ministry of Human Rights for their on-going and new schemes.

5. The Secretary, Ministry of Human Rights, along with his team, accordingly briefed the Committee about the status of ongoing projects and details of the proposed new projects. The Committee was informed that a total of Rs. 495.00 million for ongoing and new

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projects is being proposed for 2022-23, out of which Rs. 150.00 million have been allocated for nine (09) on-going Projects and Rs.345.0 million have been allocated for eight (08) new Projects. The Chairman Committee inquired about the difference between proposed allocation for the ongoing and new projects. The Secretary, Ministry of Human Rights, answered that most ongoing projects are substantially complete whereas new projects are being proposed afresh towards implementation of the robust legislation enacted recently as well as for improved outreach with international fora to sensitize them about the initiatives take by the State of Pakistan towards protecting the rights of its citizenry, especially the vulnerable segments of society, and for adhering to international obligations. In this regard, specific reference was made to the implementation of the Zainab Alert, Response and Recovery Act, for which an allocation of Rs. 30.000 Million is being proposed for 2022-23. The project objectives include Training, Awareness, Legal Literacy, Negotiation, Mediation, Reconciliation and Arbitration services to the ADR Committees of Police Stations, Local Government Officials, School Teachers, and Human Rights Activists at Community Level, especially in vulnerable communities, which have difficulties in approaching courts, cannot afford lawyers or understand cumbersome court procedures. These services will also be extended to the provision of online services.

- The Committee appreciated the proposed projects and also stressed the need of timely completion of projects as well development of impact evaluation procedures. The Chairman Committee made specific reference to the proposed National Programme for Gender Equality and Women Empowerment, which is aimed at improving Pakistan's ranking in the Global Gender Parity Index. He observed that he had already raised this issue on the floor of the House and it is heartening to see that this Programme is part of Ministry's upcoming development projects.
- 7. The Committee endorsed the budgetary proposals of the Ministry of Human Rights relating to PSDP for the Financial Year 2022-23, and recommended an allocation of Rs. 495.00 million for 17 schemes for the next FY' PSDP 2022-23. (The PSDP Budget, as duly approved by the Committee, is annexed herewith).
