The following Acts of Parliament received the assent of the President on the 14th and 15th July, 1976, respectively, and are hereby published for general information:—


ACT No. XLIX of 1976

An Act further to amend the Industrial Relations Ordinance, 1969

Whereas it is expedient further to amend the Industrial Relations Ordinance, 1969 (XXIII of 1969), for the purposes hereinafter appearing;

It is hereby enacted as follows:—

- 1. Short title, extent and commencement.—(1) This Act may be called the Industrial Relations (Amendment) Act, 1976.
 - (2) It extends to the whole of Pakistan.
 - (3) It shall come into force at once.
- 2. Amendment of section 1, Ordinance XXIII of 1969.—In the Industrial Relations Ordinance, 1969 (XXIII of 1969), in section 1,—
 - (a) in sub-section (3), after the word "Corporation" at the end, the words, commas and figures "or drawing wages in such pay group, not lower than group V, in the establishment of that Corporation as the Federal Government may, in the public interest or in the interest of security of the airlines, by notification in the official Gazette, specify by notification in the official Gazette, specify in this behalf" shall be added and
 - (b) after sub-section (3) amended as aforesaid, the following new sub-section shall be inserted, namely:—
 - "(3A) Without prejudice to the provisions of sub-section (3), for a period of sixty days from the commencement of the Industrial Relations (Amendment) Act, 1976, this Ordinance shall not apply



to any person employed in the establishment of the Pakistan International Airlines Corporation.".

3. Cancellation of registration of certain trade unions.—Notwithstanding anything contained in the Industrial Relations Ordinance, 1969 (XXIII of 1969), the registration of, and the certificates of registration issued to, all registered trade unions in the establishment of the Pakistan International Airlines Corporation shall stand cancelled.
