## SENATE OF PAKISTAN SENATE DEBATES

The Senate of Pakistan met in the Senate Hall (Parliament House) Islamabad at two minutes past three in the evening with Mr. Chairman (Muhammad Sadiq Sanjrani) in the Chair.
