13. ***Mr. Karim Ahmed Khawaja:** (Notice received on 08-02-2013 at 14:10 p.m.)

Will the Minister for Law, Justice and Human Rights be pleased to state:

- (a) *the details of cases lying pending in each High Court with category-wise break-up; and*
- (b) *the reasons for not disposing off the said cases so far and the time by which the same will be disposed off?*

Minister for Law, Justice and Human Rights: (a) The information regarding pending cases at High Courts is as under:—

- i. Lahore High Court, Lahore Annex-I (as on 31-12-2012)
 - ii. High Court of Sindh, Karachi Annex-II (as on 28-2-2013)
 - iii. Peshawar High Court, Peshawar Annex-III (as on 31-12-2011)
 - iv. High Court of Balochistan, Quetta Annex-IV (as on 31-12-2011)
 - v. Islamabad High Court, Islamabad Annex-V (as on 31-7-2013)
- (b) The reason for non-disposal of cases is not confined only to High Courts which face shortage of Court rooms and Judges. The institution of cases / litigation has jumped up due to law and order situation as well as the awareness of general public towards their rights.

14. ***Mr. Karim Ahmed Khawaja:** (Notice received on 08-02-2013 at 14:10 p.m.)

Will the Minister for Law, Justice and Human Rights be pleased to state:

- (a) *the details of cases lying pending in the Supreme Court of Pakistan with category-wise break-up; and*
- (b) *the reasons for not disposing off the said cases so far and the time by which the same will be disposed off?*

Minister for Law, Justice and Human Rights: (a) The information is not available in this Division. Therefore, the Registrar of Supreme Court of Pakistan was requested to provide the requisite information. Will the Minister for Law, Justice and Human Rights be pleased to state:

- (a) *the details of suo moto action taken by each High Court of the country since 2009;*
- (b) *the number of the said cases disposed off so far; and*
- (c) *the number of the said cases lying pending at present and the time by which the same will be disposed off?*

Minister for Law, Justice and Human Rights: (a) , (b) and (c)

- (i) The High Court of Sindh, Karachi vide its letter [Annex 'A'] informed that no *Suo Moto* action taken by that court since 2009.
- (ii) The Islamabad High Court, Islamabad - vide its letter (Annex-'B') intimated that such information amounts to have a check on Judiciary which militates against its independence.
- (iii) The Lahore High Court Lahore vide its letter dated 17-04-2013 stated that the requisite information may be obtained from Law and Justice Commission

of Pakistan where the data of all cases of all the courts is maintained and monitored under National Judicial Policy. [Annex-‘C’] The Law and Justice Commission vide its reference dated 09-05-2013 informed that the requisite information may be obtained from the Registrar of all the High Courts.[Annex-‘D’].

2. The information from Lahore High Court, Peshawar High Court & Balochistan High Court is still awaited.

67. *Col. (R) Syed Tahir Hussain Mashhadi: (Notice received on 18-02-2013 at 09:30 a.m.)

Will the Minister for Communications be pleased to state:

- (a) *whether it is a fact that the contract for Karachi - Hyderabad Motorway (M-9) project was awarded to a Malaysian Company ‘Vinapuri’ on the basis of BOT;*
- (b) *whether it is also a fact that the said contract has been cancelled, if so, the reasons therefore; and*
- (c) *the time by which the construction of the said motorway will be restarted?*

Minister for Communications: (a) Yes, the concession agreement was signed on January 16, 2012 with M/s Bina Puri of Malaysia for construction of Karachi- Hyderabad Motorway (M-9) project on BOT basis.

(b) Yes, the contract was terminated because of failure on the part of M/s Bina Puri to achieve Financial Close within stipulated time period *i.e* till July 15, 2012.

(c) Expected month for start of said projects is August 20 14 .

The project has been advertised for BOT Basis [Annex-A]. As soon as codal Formalities are completed, project Implementation shall commence.

Minister for Communications: (a) NHA has planned/undertaken construction of Faisalabad - Khanewal - Multan Motorway (M-4, 241 km) in four packages:—

(b) Faisalabad - Gojra (Pack-I). Work is likely to be completed by December-2013.

Gojra - Shorkot - Khanewal (Packs-II & III). Land acquisition is held up due to non availability of funds. Work will be awarded once land acquisition process is completed. After award of works, planned construction period will be 30 months.

Khanewal - Multan (Pack-V). Work is likely to be completed by December-2014.

Will the Minister for National Health Services, Regulations and Coordination be pleased to state:

- (a) *the names of Government employees in BPS-20 and above who were allowed medical treatment abroad on Government expenses during the last five years indicating also the expenses incurred in each case;*
- (b) *the names of parliamentarians who were allowed the said facility during that period indicating also the expenses incurred in each case; and*
- (c) *the names of judges of the Supreme Court of Pakistan and High Courts in the country who were allowed that facility during the said period indicating also the expenses incurred in each case?*

Mrs. Saira Afzal Tarar: (a) After 18th Constitutional Amendment, in terms of rule 3(3) of Rules of Business, 1973, the Prime Minister of Pakistan has been pleased to transfer the subject of “International aspects of medical facilities abroad” from Economic Affairs Division and placed it under the newly created ministry i.e Ministry of Nation Health Services, Regulation and Coordination w.e.f 12-06-2012. A total of twelve (12) number of Federal Government Employees of BS-20 and above have got medical treatment abroad on Government expenditure since Jan 2008 to till date (Annex-I). Information prior to 12-06-2012 was sought from Economic Affairs Division and the erstwhile Ministry of Health as relevant data was not transferred to this Ministry. However they have not replied officially to date but this ministry has obtained old data utilizing its own resources which has been incorporated in the reply.

(b) A total of 10 Parliamentarians got that treatment done from abroad since 2008 till date. The details of which is placed at Annex-II.

(c) A total of 1 Judge of Supreme Court of Pakistan got that treatment done from abroad since 2008 till date. The details of which is placed at Annex-III.

Will the Minister for Ports and Shipping be pleased to state:

(a) *the name of the company of Singapore with which agreement regarding operation of Gwadar Port was signed;*

(b) *the period for which the said agreement was signed; and*

(c) *whether the agreement is being implemented at present or otherwise?*

Mr. Kamran Michael: (a) The agreement was signed between Gwadar Port Authority and PSA Gwadar PTE. LTD.

(b) The agreement was signed for forty (40) years.

(c) The Concession Agreement 2007 is being implemented at present.

45. ***Mrs. Naseema Ehsan:** (Notice received on 15-03-2013 at 10:15 a.m.)

Will the Minister for Communications be pleased to state whether there is any proposal under consideration of the Government to link Turbat city with M-8, if so, when?

Minister for Communications: Two lane Gwadar-Turbat-Hoshab Road (M-8, 193 km) is already under construction. It passes at a distance of about 4 km from Turbat City; which is planned to be linked through a local road.

Presently, work on the project is suspended due to adverse law and order situation. Overall progress is 65%.

46. ***Mr. Hamza :** (Notice received on 15-03-2013 at 10:15 a.m.)

Will the Minister for Communications be pleased to state:

- (a) *the estimated cost of construction of motorway (M-4);*
- (b) *the date of completion of the project;*
- (c) *the number of underpasses constructed on the said motorway indicating also the width and height of the same;*
- (d) *whether it is a fact that width and height of the said underpasses is not of required standard, if so, its reasons; and*
- (e) *the steps being taken to rectify the situation?*

Minister for Communications: (a) & (b) NHA has planned/undertaken construction of Faisalabad - Khanewal - Multan Motorway (M-4) in four packages. Work on only two packages is ongoing. Estimated cost as per approved PC-I is Rs 47.016 Billion. Progress of each package is as indicated :

*** Land

Cost has increased, as original PC-I was prepared in Sep-2007 while contract for Faisalabad - Gojra (58 km) only was awarded for Rs 10.289 billion. Contracts for Gojra - Shorkot -Dinpur-Khanewal (126 km) are yet to be awarded. These packages are getting delayed as additional funds required for land acquisition (approx Rs 1.821 billion) have not yet been provided by GoP.

(c) Five different types of crossing structures have been provided in Faisalabad-Gojra (Pack-I):

(d) It is confirmed that international design standards have been used for crossing structures. Size of underpasses (provided on major roads) has been kept as 7.3 x 5.3 m. Size of road underpasses is 4.5 x 4.5 m. While of subways, it is 4 x 4 m as these have been provided on minor / farm-to-market roads. Width of all crossing structures has been kept symmetric to width of crossing roads / tracks. As per international standards, width of loads (loaded trolley / truck) is restricted to 2.6 m while height of carriage (loaded trolley/truck with loads) from ground level to top cannot be more than 4.0 m.

(e) Width & height of underpasses / subways is as per international design standards. A total of 62 crossing structures have been catered for in a 58 km length although as per international standards, one crossing structure is to be provided in every two km. Therefore, the underpasses / subways provided in the contract are adequate. Still, however, additional 1 x subway and 5 x cattle creeps have been provided to satisfy public demand.

Minister for Communications: (a) The estimated construction cost of Bridge across River Chenab linking Shorkot-Garh Maharaja including river training works and approach roads being executed in packages is Rs 2547.460 million:—

Project will be inaugurated after completion of main bridge and approach roads expected in Dec-2013.

(b) Main bridge and approach roads are expected to be completed by Dec-2013 subject to smooth flow of funds. However, river training works are likely to be completed by Mar-2014.

Minister for Communications: (a) At present 12035 Post Offices are functioning throughout the Country, details and District - wise break up is enclosed as **Annexure-A.**

(b) There was no profit earned by the Pakistan Post during the last three financial years. However the position of Expenditure, Revenue and deficit during the last three financial years is given as under :—

The year wise and head wise breakup of revenue earned and expenditure incurred by the Pakistan Post Office Department during the last three financial years is given in attached **Annexure-B & C.**

The main -reasons of deficit are noted as under :—

- (i) Increase in expenditure due to grant of adhoc relia(in Pay and Pension during F.Y. 2009-10 to 2011-12; grant of adhoc allowance @ 50% of Pay during F.Y. 2010-11; revision of pay scales and enhancement in the rate of conveyance allowance etc. during F.Y. 2011-12.
- (ii) Reduction in the rate of Post Office commission on Savings Schemes work from Rs. 1.50% to Rs. 0.50% w.e.f October 2010 by the Finance Division due to which Revenue of the Pakistan Post has been reduced by Rs. 1.5 billion annually.
- (iii) Non revision of Postal tariff which was last revised in the year 2009.

- (b) 1. Khanewal-Multan Inter District Road (Bosan Road) (Pack-II). Release of 3rd quarter tranche of NHA's PSDP allocation 2012-13 is still awaited from the Finance Division. Liabilities & claims of FWO will be released on receipt of funds.
2. West Bank Bypass (Muzaffarabad City, AJ&K) (Pack-II). Project has been undertaken by NHA as "deposit work" on behalf of Earthquake Reconstruction & Rehabilitation Authority (ERRA). Liabilities & claims of FWO will be released on receipt of funds from ERRA.
3. Torkham-Jalalabad Road Afghanistan. Funds for this project were provided by GoP through a special grant of USD 100 million under the auspices of the Council for Rehabilitation & Reconstruction of Afghanistan (CRRA). Liabilities & claims of FWO will be released on receipt of funds from CRRA.

Minister for Communications: (a) The fund is being maintained as per Section 89 and 93 of National Highways Safety Ordinance 2000 and NH&MP (Road Safety Campaign, Performance Reward) Rules-2007. 50% share of fine collected at motorways and national highways is the source of generation.

(b) & (c) The funds transferred to NH&MP is used as under;

Construction work has not yet started due to revision of land acquisition policy by ADB, which entails heavy payments to land owners over & above the cost established by District Revenue Officers. This appears difficult due to additional financial burden on PSDP and being in contradiction to the provisions of Land Acquisition Act, 1894.

Commencement of work is also delayed because approval of PC-1, which has been cleared by CDWP but ECNEC is awaited.

(b) Phase-I. Work can commence in 2013-14 subject to approval of PC-I and allocation / provision of necessary funds. Pack-wise progress is as follows:—

Packs-I & III. Procurement process will be initiated on completion of land acquisition.

Pack-II. Jarikas - Sarae Saleh Chowk is ready for construction subject to conditions of resettlement imposed by ADB.

Phase-II. Delayed as land acquisition and design process will commence after finalization of alignment.
