

## **RESOLUTION NO. 530**

"The House is cognizant of the longstanding electricity crisis in the country and high electricity tariffs in the country causing heavy burden on domestic, commercial and industrial consumers.

The House recommends that the Government may allow Public-Private Partnership and Private Sector to install their own energy parks in the country with minimum thirty Mega Watts electricity generation capacity.

The House further recommends that the said energy parks may be authorized to sell electricity to the consumers on pre-determined tariff formula and install their own captive transmission and distribution grids for domestic, commercial and industrial consumers and / or the distribution be allowed through wheeling charges."
