REPORTS OF THE STANDING COMMITTEE - PRESENTATION OF:

1. Senator Walid Iqbal, Chairman, Standing Committee on Human Rights, presented report of the Committee on the Bill to establish an effective system of protection, relief and rehabilitation of women, children, elders and any vulnerable person against domestic violence [The Domestic Violence (Prevention and Protection) Bill, 2021].
2. Senator Walid Iqbal, Chairman, Standing Committee on Human Rights, presented report of the Committee on the Bill to provide for the well-being, comfort and dignity of the senior citizens residing in the Islamabad Capital Territory [The Islamabad Capital Territory Senior Citizens Bill, 2021].

MOTION
[Under Rule 263]

Mr. Ali Muhammad Khan, Minister of State for Parliamentary Affairs on behalf of Mr. Zaheer-Ud-Din Babar Awan Adviser to the Prime Minister on Parliamentary Affairs, moved under Rule 263 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the Senate, 2012, that the requirement of Rule 120 of the said Rules regarding notice period, be dispensed with in order to take into consideration the Bills at Order No.5 to 8.

LEGISLATIVE BUSINESS

1. Mr. Ali Muhammad Khan, Minister of State for Parliamentary Affairs on behalf of Mr. Zaheer-Ud-Din Babar Awan, Adviser to the Prime Minister on Parliamentary Affairs, moved that the Bill to re-organize the Federal medical teaching institutes and teaching hospitals thereof [The Federal Medical Teaching Institutes Bill, 2021], as passed by the National Assembly, be taken into consideration.

The Bill was referred to the Standing Committee concerned for consideration and report.

2. Mr. Ali Muhammad Khan, Minister of State for Parliamentary Affairs on behalf of Adviser to the Prime Minister on Parliamentary Affairs, moved that the Bill to re-organize and create the National Institute of Health [The National Institute of Health (Re-organization) Bill, 2021], as passed by the National Assembly, be taken into consideration.

The Bill was referred to the Standing Committee concerned for consideration and report.

3. Mr. Ali Muhammad Khan, Minister of State for Parliamentary Affairs on behalf of Sheikh Rashid Ahmed, Minister for Interior, moved that the Bill further to amend the Mutual Legal Assistance (Criminal Matters) Act, 2020 [The Mutual Legal Assistance (Criminal Matters) (Amendment) Bill, 2021], as passed by the National Assembly, be taken into consideration.

The Bill was referred to the Standing Committee concerned for consideration and report.

4. Mr. Ali Muhammad Khan, Minister of State for Parliamentary Affairs on behalf of Senator Dr. Muhammad Farogh Naseem, Minister for Law and Justice, moved that the Bill to amend the Enforcement of Women's Property Rights Act, 2020 [The Enforcement of Women's Property Rights (Amendment) Bill, 2021], as passed by the National Assembly, be taken into consideration.

The Bill was referred to the Standing Committee concerned for consideration and report.
