Senator Saifullah Abro, Chairman, Standing Committee on Power, presented report of the Committee on the Bill further to amend the Regulation of Generation, Transmission and Distribution of Electric Power Act, 1997 [The Regulation of Generation, Transmission and Distribution of Electric Power (Amendment) Bill, 2021].

Mr. Ali Muhammad Khan, Minister of State for Parliamentary Affairs on behalf of Ms. Zartaj Gul, Minister of State for Climate Change, moved that the Bill to amend the Global Change Impact Studies Centre Act, 2013 [The Global change Impact Studies Centre (Amendment) Bill, 2021], as passed by the National Assembly, be taken into consideration.

The Bill was referred to the Standing Committee concerned for consideration and report.

Mr. Ali Muhammad Khan, Minister of State for Parliamentary Affairs on behalf of Mr. Noor-Ul-Haq Qadri, Minister for Religious Affairs and Inter-faith Harmony, moved that the Bill further to amend the Protection of Communal Properties of Minorities Ordinance, 2001 [The Protection of Communal Properties of Minorities (Amendment) Bill, 2021], as passed by the National Assembly, be taken into consideration.

The Bill was referred to the Standing Committee concerned for consideration and report.

12. Mr. Ali Muhammad Khan, Minister of State for Parliamentary Affairs on behalf of Sheikh Rashid Ahmed, Minister for Interior, moved that the Bill to regulate the Registration, Regulation and Facilitation of Charities in the Islamabad Capital Territory [The Islamabad Capital Territory Charities Registration, Regulation and Facilitation Bill, 2021], as passed by the National Assembly, be taken into consideration.

The Bill was referred to the Standing Committee concerned for consideration and report.

Mr. Ali Muhammad Khan, Minister of State for Parliamentary Affairs on behalf of Sheikh Rashid Ahmed, Minister for Interior, moved that the Bill to provide for the prevention of hoarding in respect of scheduled articles, in the wake of an emergent situation resulting from the outbreak of the Corona virus

pandemic (COVID-19) [The COVID-19 (Prevention of Hoarding) Bill, 2021], as passed by the National Assembly, be taken into consideration.

The Bill was referred to the Standing Committee concerned for consideration and report.

Mr. Ali Muhammad Khan, Minister of State for Parliamentary Affairs on behalf of Syed Ali Haider Zaidi, Minister for Maritime Affairs, moved that the Bill further to amend the Port Qasim Authority Act, 1973 [The Port Qasim Authority (Amendment) Bill, 2021], as passed by the National Assembly, be taken into consideration.
