Leave applications were read by the Chairman Senate.

**PRESENTATION OF REPORTS OF THE STANDING COMMITTEES -**

1. Senator Mohsin Aziz, Chairman, Standing Committee on Interior, presented report of the Committee on the Bill further to amend the Pakistan Penal Code, 1860 and the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1898 [The Criminal Laws (Amendment) Bill, 2021], introduced by Senator Syed Muhammad Sabir Shah on 25<sup>th</sup> January, 2021.
2. Senator Mohsin Aziz, Chairman, Standing Committee on Interior, presented report of the Committee on the Bill further to amend the Islamabad Rent Restriction Ordinance, 2001 [The Islamabad Rent Restriction (Amendment) Bill, 2021], introduced by Senator Mohsin Aziz on 25<sup>th</sup> January, 2021.
3. Senator Zeeshan Khan Zada, Chairman, Standing Committee on Commerce, presented report of the Committee on the Bill to amend the Trade Organizations Act, 2013 [The Trade Organizations (Amendment) Bill, 2021], introduced by Senator Fawzia Arshad on 27<sup>th</sup> September, 2021.
4. Senator Rubina Khalid, Chairperson, Standing Committee on Maritime Affairs, presented report of the Committee on a point of public importance raised by Senator Muhammad Tahir Bizinjo during the sitting of the Senate held on 14<sup>th</sup> June, 2021 regarding "Fishing by Chinese Trawlers in Balochistan's territorial waters."

5. Senator Saleem Mandviwalla, Chairman, Standing Committee on Planning, Development and Special Initiatives, presented special report of the Committee on the recurrent annual untimeliness and futility of the Senate of Pakistan's recommendatory role in the PSDP.

### **REPORT LAID BEFORE THE SENATE**

Mr. Ali Muhammad Khan, Minister of State for Parliamentary Affairs on behalf of Minister In-Charge for Finance and Revenue, laid before the Senate the Report on 1<sup>st</sup> Biannual Monitoring on the Implementation of NFC Award (July-December, 2020), as required under clause (3B) of Article 160 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan.

### **LAYING A COPY OF THE MONEY BILL**

Mr. Ali Muhammad Khan, Minister of State for Parliamentary Affairs on behalf of Minister In-Charge for Finance and Revenue, laid before the Senate a copy of the Money Bill, the Tax Laws (Third Amendment) Bill, 2021, as required under Article 73 of the Constitution.

Thereafter, Mr. Ali Muhammad Khan, Minister of State for Parliamentary Affairs on behalf of Minister In-Charge for Finance and Revenue, moved that the Senate may make recommendations, if any, to the National Assembly on the Money Bill, the Tax Laws (Third Amendment) Bill, 2021, as required under Article 73 of the Constitution.

**The Money Bill was referred to the Standing Committee on Finance and Revenue for making recommendations thereon to the National Assembly within 14 days.**

### **POINT OF ORDER**

Senator Mian Raza Rabbani raised Point of Order regarding delayed laying of Money Bill in the Senate in violation of the Constitution which provides that Money Bill shall be laid in both the House simultaneously. .

**Chairman ruled that the Money Bill was placed on the agenda for laying on the very first day of the session after its summoning and the 14 day time for recommendation shall start from its laying in the Senate.**

2. Mr. Ali Muhammad Khan, Minister of State for Parliamentary Affairs on behalf of Mr. Ghulam sarwar khan Minister for Aviation Division laid before the Senate, the Pakistan Airports Authority Ordinance, 2021 (Ordinance No. XIV of 2021), as required by clause (2) of Article 89 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan.
3. Mr. Ali Muhammad Khan, Minister of State for Parliamentary Affairs on behalf of Mr. Asad Umer Minister for Planning, Development and Special Initiatives, laid before the Senate, the Federal Government Properties Management Authority Ordinance, 2021 (Ordinance No. XV of 2021), as required by clause (2) of Article 89 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan.

## **UNANIMOUS RESOLUTION**

The Motion was put to the House and adopted.

Thereafter, the Resolution was moved by Senator Kamil Ali Agha which was put to the House and passed unanimously.

The Chairman directed to send copy of the resolution to the Prime Minister Office and Cabinet Division.
