1. Senator Prince Ahmed Umer Ahmedzai, Chairman, Standing Committee on Communications, moved under sub-rule (1) of Rule 194 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the Senate, 2012, that the time for presentation of the report of the Committee on the Bill further to amend the National Highways Safety Ordinance, 2000, [The National Highways Safety (Amendment) Bill, 2020], introduced by Senator Bahramand Khan Tangi on 25th January, 2021, may be extended for a period of sixty (60) days with effect from 1st February, 2022.

The Motion was put to the House and carried.

Senator Mohsin Aziz, Chairman, Standing Committee on Interior, presented report of the Committee on the subject matter of Starred Question No.56, asked by Senator Kamran Murtaza on 29th December, 2021, regarding the policy of the Federal Government to control incidents of car lifting/ theft across the country in coordination with the Provincial Governments.

Mr. Ali Muhammad Khan, Minister of State for Parliamentary Affairs on behalf of Senator Dr. Muhammad Farogh Naseem, Minister for Law and Justice, moved that the Bill to provide for the protection of parents [The Protection of Parents Bill, 2022], as passed by the National Assembly, be taken into consideration.

The Motion was put to the House and leave to introduce the bill was granted. The Bill introduced and referred to Standing Committee concerned.

3. Mr. Ali Muhammad Khan, Minister of State for Parliamentary Affairs on behalf of Senator Shaukat Fayaz Ahmed Tarin, Minister for Finance and Revenue, moved that the Bill further to amend the Securities and Exchange Commission of Pakistan Act, 1997 [The Securities and Exchange Commission of Pakistan (Amendment) Bill, 2022], as passed by the National Assembly, be taken into consideration.

The Motion was put to the House and leave to introduce the bill was granted. The Bill introduced and referred to Standing Committee concerned.
