

4. **Amendment of section 56, Ordinance XXXV of 1961.**—In the said Ordinance, in section 56, after the word “service” at the end, the words “and shall also be liable to fine” shall be added.

5. **Amendment of section 63, Ordinance XXXV of 1961.**—In the said Ordinance, in section 63, after the word “imprisonment” at the end, the words “and shall also be liable to fine” shall be added.

6. **Amendment of section 64, Ordinance XXXV of 1961.**—In the said Ordinance, in section 64, after the word “imprisonment” at the end, the words “and shall also be liable to fine” shall be added.

7. **Amendment of section 65, Ordinance, XXXV of 1961.**—In the said Ordinance, in section 65, after the word “imprisonment” at the end, the words “and shall also be liable to fine” shall be added.

ACT No. X OF 2005

An Act further to amend the Federal Public Service Commission Ordinance, 1977

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the Federal Public Service Commission Ordinance, 1977 (XLV of 1977), for the purposes hereinafter appearing;

It is hereby enacted as follows:—

1. **Short title and commencement.**—(1) This Act may be called the Federal Public Service Commission (Second Amendment) Act, 2005.

(2) It shall come into force at once and shall be deemed to have taken effect on, and from, the 28th May, 2003.

2. **Amendment of section 7, Ordinance XLV of 1977.**—In the Federal Public Service Commission Ordinance, 1977 (XLV of 1977), in section 7, in sub-section (1),—

(i) for clause (a) the following shall be substituted, namely:—

“(a) to conduct tests and examinations for recruitment of persons to All-Pakistan Services, the civil services of the Federation and civil posts in connection with the affairs of the Federation in basic pay scales 16 and above or equivalent;” and

(ii) after sub-section (1), amended as aforesaid, the following new sub-section shall be inserted, namely:—

“(1a) The recruitment to the posts in basic pay scales 11 to 15 made by any authority or person on or after the 28th May 2003, other than through the Commission, shall, notwithstanding any provision of this Ordinance or any other law, rule, notification or any order, decision of judgment of any court or forum, be deemed to be, and always to have been, validly made, taken or done and shall not be called in question in any court or forum or any ground whatsoever.”
