The following Act of Majlis-e-Shoora (Parliament) received the assent of the President on the 18th May, 1994, and is hereby published for general information:—

ACT No. III OF 1994

An Act further to amend the Customs Act, 1969

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the Customs Act, 1969 (IV of 1969), for the purpose hereinafter appearing;

It is enacted as follows:—

1. **Short title and commencement.**—(1) This Act may be called the Customs (Amendment) Act, 1994.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. **Amendment of section 98, Act IV of 1969.**—In the Customs Act, 1969 (IV of 1969), in section 98, for sub-section (1), the following shall be substituted, namely:—

“(1) Warehoused goods, other than consumer goods as notified by the Central Board of Revenue, may remain in the warehouse for a period of

three months following the date of their admission into the warehouse and consumer goods so notified may remain in the warehouse for a period of one month following the said date :

Provided that the said period may, in case of non perishable goods, be extended by the Board or by such officer as authorized by the Board in this behalf, on sufficient cause being shown by the owner of the warehoused goods and subject to the condition that he pays in advance surcharge on the duty and taxes involved at two per cent per month for the extended period."
