The following Acts of Majlis-e-Shoora (Parliament) received the assent of the President on the 15th July, 1985, and are hereby published for general information :—

ACT No. XI OF 1985

An Act further to amend the Representation of the People Act, 1976

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the Representation of the People Act, 1976 (LXXXV of 1976), for the purposes hereinafter appearing ;

It is hereby enacted as follows :—

1. Short title and commencement.—(1) This Act may be called the Representation of the People (Eighth Amendment) Act, 1985.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. Amendment of section 50, Act LXXXV of 1976.—In the Representation of the People Act, 1976 (LXXXV of 1976), hereinafter referred to as the said Act, in section 50, after sub-section (2), the following new sub-section shall be added, namely :—

“(3) Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-section (1), a contesting candidate at the elections held under the Houses of Parliament and Provincial Assemblies (Elections) Order, 1977, shall not be required to submit a return of election expenses.”.

3. **Amendment of section 99, Act LXXXV of 1976.**—In the said Act, in section 99, in sub-section (1), after clause (e), the following new clause shall be inserted, namely :—

“(ee) he, being a person elected to the National Assembly or a Provincial Assembly, is found by the Commission to have subscribed, after the commencement of the Representation of the People (Eighth Amendment) Ordinance, 1985, either as proposer or seconder, in contravention of the provisions of this Act or the rules made thereunder, to the nomination of more than one candidate for a seat or seats ; or”.

4. **Repeal.**—The Representation of the People (Eighth Amendment) Ordinance, 1985 (XXVI of 1985), is hereby repealed.
