The following Acts of Parliament received the assent of the President on the 31st December, 1973, and are hereby published for general information :—

further to amend the Post Office Act, 1898

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the Post Office Act, 1898 (VI of 1898), for the purpose hereinafter appearing;

It is hereby enacted as follows:—

1. **Short title and commencement.**—(1) This Act may be called the Post Office (Amendment) Act, 1973.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. **Amendment of section 45, Act VI of 1898.**—In the Post Office Act, 1898 (VI of 1898), in section 45, in the proviso, for the words "ten rupees" the words "fifty rupees" shall be substituted.

3. **Repeal.**—The Post Office (Amendment) Ordinance, 1973 (XXIV of 1973), is hereby repealed.
