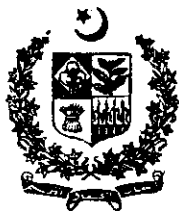

The following Acts of Parliament received the assent of the President on the 19th December, 1975, are hereby published for general information :—

ACT No. LXXXIV OF 1975

An Act further to amend the West Pakistan Water and Power Development Authority Act, 1958

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the West Pakistan Water and Power Development Authority Act, 1958 (West Pakistan Act No. XXXI of 1958), for the purposes hereinafter appearing :

It is hereby enacted as follows :—

1. Short title and commencement.—(1) This Act may be called the West Pakistan Water and Power Development Authority (Amendment) Act, 1975.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. Amendment of section 17, W.P. Act No. XXXI of 1958.—In the West Pakistan Water and Power Development Authority Act, 1958 (West Pakistan Act No. XXXI of 1958), in section 17, after sub-section (1), the following new sub-sections shall be inserted, namely :—

“(1A) Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-section (1) or any rules made, or orders or instructions issued, by the Authority, or in the terms and conditions of service of any person employed by, or serving under the Authority, the Authority may, at any time, retire or remove from its service any person without assigning any reason, after giving him not less than thirty days’ notice or pay for the period by which such notice falls short of thirty days.

(1B) Service under the Authority is hereby declared to be service of Pakistan and every person holding a post under the Authority, not being a person who is on deputation to the Authority from any Province, shall be deemed to be a civil servant for the purposes of the Service Tribunals Act, 1973 (LXX of 1973).”.

3. Repeal.—The West Pakistan Water and Power Development Authority (Amendment) Ordinance, 1975 (XVI of 1975), is hereby repealed.
