Acts, Ordinances, President's Orders and Regulations

*Islamabad, the 6th December, 1975*

The following Act of Parliament received the assent of the President on the 4th December, 1975, and is hereby published for general information :—

ACT No. LXXIII OF 1975

*An Act further to amend the Pakistan Army Act, 1952*

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the Pakistan Army Act, 1952 (XXXIX of 1952), for the purposes hereinafter appearing ;

It is hereby enacted as follows :—

1. **Short title and commencement.**—(1) This Act may be called the Pakistan Army (Amendment) Act, 1975.

(2) It shall come into force at once and section 2 shall be deemed to have taken effect on the sixteenth day of December, 1971.

2. **Amendment of section 2, Act XXXIX of 1952.**—In the Pakistan Army Act, 1952 (XXXIX of 1952), hereinafter referred to as the said Act, in section 2,—

(1) in sub-section (1), in clause (d), for the full stop at the end a semi-colon shall be substituted, and thereafter the following new clause shall be added, namely :—

“(e) persons not otherwise subject to this Act who belonged to the former East Pakistan Civil Armed Forces and were repatriated to Pakistan after the sixteenth day of December, 1971.”; and

(2) in sub-section (2), after the words, brackets and letter “or clause (b)”, the words, brackets and letter “or clause (e)” shall be inserted.

**3. Insertion of new section 2B, Act XXXIX of 1952.**—In the said Act, after section 2A, the following new section shall be inserted, namely :—

“2B. *Secondment to other armed forces.*—The Federal Government may by order in writing direct that any person referred to in clause (a) of sub-section (1) of section 2, other than a junior commissioned officer or warrant officer, shall, under such conditions as may be laid down by regulations, be seconded for service with any other armed forces raised or maintained by the Federal Government, including civil armed forces.”.

**4. Repeal.**—The Pakistan Army (Amendment) Ordinance, 1975 (XIV of 1975), is hereby repealed.
