RESOLUTIONS

48. SENATOR SEEMEE EZDI, to move the following resolution:-

"Noting the recommendations presented in IMF's recent report on public investment of Pakistan indicating that Pakistan's economy is going to be affected @ 9% by natural disasters;

Acknowledging that Pakistan is among the countries more likely to be effected by the climate change as manifested in the shape of floods in 2022;

Observing that since 2000, Pakistan has been facing an estimated annual loss of over \$2 billion due to the climate changes; around 500 people are being killed, over four million people being affected and agriculture and other infrastructure destroyed in the country;

The Senate of Pakistan, therefore, recommends that the Government should prioritize climate change projects in its development Budget and allocate sufficient funds for climate change adaptation and preparedness in this regard."

49. SENATOR BAHRAMAND KHAN TANGI, to move the following resolution:-

"Cognizant of the huge sacrifices of Armed forces and other security agencies in the war against terror and for the Defence and protection of the country's borders;

Acknowledging the fact that strong army and other security agencies is indispensable for the Defence of the country especially in view of the hostile neighborhood;

Expressing deep concern on the negative and malicious propaganda against the armed forces and other security agencies on various social media platforms;

The Senate of Pakistan, therefore, recommends to the Government to take necessary steps to award severe punishment including disqualification for any public office for ten years for all those found involved in negative and malicious propaganda against the armed forces and other security agencies of Pakistan."

50. SENATOR SAMINA MUMTAZ ZEHRI, to move the following resolution:-

"Recognizing the increasing usage of hard drugs such as heroin, cocaine ecstasy pills, shisha, cannabis (charas), injected drugs and alcohol by university students at the university campuses;

Noting that the hostelized students are more frequent drug users as compared to non-hostellers inside the university campuses;

Further noting that there are almost nine million drug addicts in the country including two million of them between the age of 15 to 25 years, this issue is resulting in serious social and health implications for the country;

The Senate of Pakistan, therefore, recommends that the Government should take immediate steps:

- i. to cater to the needs of all students with diverse cultural backgrounds and to reform the higher education curriculum to apprise students of the consequences and risks of drug usage; and
- ii to devise a monitoring mechanism in all the universities for enforcement of the 'Policy on Drug and Tobacco Abuse in Higher Education Institutions 2021' in letter and spirit."

MOTIONS **[Under Rule 218]**
