RESOLUTION

22. SENATOR MOHAMMAD ABDUL QADIR, to move the following resolution:-

Observing with a serious concern that MPhil and PhD programs of various varsities are confined to imparting conservative knowledge of Islam and history.

Realizing the need that MPhil and PhD programs in Islamic studies should be aligned with modern thinking originating from the Holy Quran.

The Senate of Pakistan, therefore, resolves that all universities of Pakistan should revise their MPhil and PhD programs and align them with the requirements of the modern times which are truly based on research, critical thinking, scientific approach and practical application of Qur'anic knowledge.

The Senate of Pakistan also recommends to the Higher Education Commission of Pakistan to develop guidelines for all the universities of Pakistan to update the syllabus of their MPhil and PhD programs and align it with modern scientific requirements."
