RESOLUTION

The House expresses its deep sorrow and grief over the loss of the precious lives in those attacks and shows solidarity with the families of the victims and prays for the early recovery of the other injured;

This House resolves that such cruel/ cowardly incidents of terrorism cannot shake the determination and commitment of this nation and its brave security forces against the terrorism;

The House expresses its grave concern on the continued use of Afghan territory by Hafiz Gul Bahadur Group and Tehrik-i- Taliban (TTP) to carry out deadly attacks in Pakistan with impunity and reiterates its calls for an immediate action from Afghan authorities against these groups and to ensure that the Afghan territory is not used for terrorism against Pakistan".
