SENATOR PERVAIZ RASHID, Chairman, Standing Committee on Communications, to move under sub-rule (1) of Rule 194 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the Senate, 2012, that the time for presentation of report of the Committee on the subject matter of a Calling Attention Notice raised by Senator Samina Mumtaz Zehri on 4th July, 2024, regarding alarming statistics revealed by the Balochistan Medical Emergency Response Center (BMERC) according to which during the last five years over 46,000 accidents have occurred on Highways of Balochistan due to their deteriorating conditions which resulted into deaths and injuries to thousands of commuters, may be extended for a period of sixty working days with effect from 4th November, 2024.
