"That the Senate resolves to extend the Virtual Assets Ordinance, 2025 (Ordinance No. VII of 2025), for a further period of one hundred and twenty days with effect from 5th November, 2025, under proviso to sub-paragraph (ii) of paragraph (a) of clause (2) of Article 89 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan."
