BILL

to amend the National Rahmatul-Lil-Aalameen Wa Khatamun Nabiyyun Authority Act, 2022

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the National Rahmatul-Lil-Aalameen Wa Khatamun Nabiyyun Authority Act, 2022 (XV of 2022), in the manner and for the purposes hereinafter appearing;

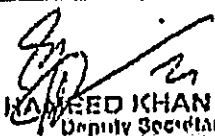
It is hereby enacted as follows:

1. Short title and commencement.—(1) This Act shall be called the National Rahmatul-Lil-Aalameen Wa Khatamun Nabiyyun Authority (Amendment) Act, 2022.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. Amendment of section 3, Act XV of 2022.—In the National Rahmatul-Lil-Aalameen Wa Khatamun Nabiyyun Authority Act, 2022 (XV of 2022), hereinafter referred to as "the said Act" in section 6, in sub-section (3), after the word and comma "members," the words "out of which two shall be female" shall be inserted.

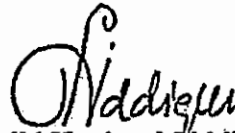
3. Amendment of section 4, Act XV of 2022.—In the said Act, in section 4, in sub-section (2), after the word "members", the comma and words ", out of which three shall be female" shall be inserted.

STATEMENT OF OBJECT AND REASONS
