A Meeting of the Senate Standing Committee on Cabinet Secretariat will be held on **10th August, 2026 at 02:30 p.m. in Committee Room No. 04, Parliament House, Islamabad.** In case of Senate Session in the evening, the meeting will be held at 11:30 a.m.

2. The **agenda** before the Committee would be as under:-

- i. Briefing by Chairman OGRA, Customs and relevant LEAs regarding terrorist attacks on LPG bowsers in Balochistan, their impact on nationwide LPG supply and prices, security measures for vulnerable routes, action against those responsible, and a time-bound plan to ensure safe and uninterrupted LPG transportation along with other goods.
- ii. **Briefing by Chairman, OGRA and Customs on the following:**
 - a. Alleged Illegal Transfer/Sale of Bonded Petroleum Products
 - i. What is the estimated loss of customs duty, taxes and petroleum levy to the national exchequer?
 - ii. Did OGRA conduct any physical inspection of the concerned licensed entities, terminals or storage facilities before or after detection of the case?
 - iii. Which officials were responsible for monitoring the relevant licenses, facilities and stock movements?
 - iv. Have any, license suspension or cancellation proceedings been initiated against the concerned entities?
 - v. By what date will OGRA integrate its monitoring data with Customs, FBR, FIA and pipeline operators?
 - vi. Will OGRA introduce independent audits and surprise inspections of bonded terminals and storage facilities?
 - vii. Who will be held accountable if regulatory negligence, facilitation or failure of oversight is established?
 - viii. What legal amendments, regulatory reforms or enhanced penalties are required to prevent recurrence?
 - b. What is the total outstanding PDC amount currently? Which five OMCs have the largest outstanding claims? How much of the claimed amount has been disallowed or deferred, and why?
 - c. Have any duplicate, inflated or unsupported PDC claims been detected? Details, if any
 - d. Progress on proposal for a SOP, requiring prior OGRA intimation/approval, outgoing OMC NOC, settlement of dues and safety verification mandatory before any change of OMC/brand at a retail outlet site.
- iii. **Chairman NEPRA should direct the CEOs of all distribution companies to give detailed briefing on following agendas:**
 - a. Detailed progress made in addressing each bottleneck in the transmission network that caused the underutilization of cheaper power generation, including corrective measures undertaken during the last year and timelines for removing the remaining constraints.
 - b. Why have DISCOs not claimed any write off as allowed in the National Electricity Policy and Plan as KE has done?
 - c. Details from DISCOs for the period from Jan -June 2026:
 - i. Month wise number of Net Metering Applications received, processed, green meters installed, billing started and pending;
 - ii. Month wise number of defective meters, meters replaced within NEPRA deadlines, meters replaced outside NEPRA deadlines, and meters are pending to be replaced;

- iii. Month wise number of new connections application received, connections given and pending despite lapse of NEPRA timelines and payment of demand notice by consumers;
- iv. Month wise number of detections bills charged along with number of units and amount.
- d. DISCO-wise details of show-cause notices, investigations, penalties, fines and corrective directions issued by NEPRA during the last three years; present compliance status; amounts recovered; and reasons for continued violations despite repeated regulatory action.
- e. Assessment of electricity theft, illegal connections, enforcement operations and recovery of arrears, including measures taken against organized theft and action against DISCO employees found facilitating theft, tampering, illegal billing adjustments or unauthorized connections.
- f. Status of DISCO privatization.
- iv. Any other item(s) with the permission of the Chair.
