A meeting of the Senate Standing Committee on Housing and Works will be held on **Wednesday, the 12<sup>th</sup> August, 2026 at 11 a.m. in Committee Room No.4, Parliament House, Islamabad.** In case of Senate session in the morning, the meeting will be held at 2:30 p.m. in the afternoon.

2. **The agenda of the meeting is appended below:-**

- (1) Report by the Secretary M/o. Housing & Works on the following issues of the Maintenance Staff of ex-Pak PWD:
  - (i) Total number pending cases since 2018 to **30-6-2025** of the Pak PWD Maintenance employees who died during service and their families have not yet been given financial assistance and other benefits admissible under the 2014<sup>th</sup> Prime Minister's Assistance Package for the in-service death of employees, giving details of date of death of the employee and the **reasons for delay** in each case and surrender of the funds/budgetary allocation for this purpose in FY 2025-26 despite the fact that these employees were on the payroll of Pak PWD till 30-6-2025.
  - (ii) Reasons for not processing and forwarding to the AGPR by the Director Budget and Account of the PWD, the 60 cases for payment of retirement related benefits including pension, gratuity, leave encashment, T.A to those Pak PWD Maintenance employees who were retired on or before 30-6-2025 when they were on the payroll of Pak PWD. The details of officers responsible for this grave negligence and utter defiance of the Federal Cabinet decision may be provided.
- (2) The Secretaries M/o. Planning (Pakistan Bureau of Statistics), M/o. Religious Affairs (Hajj Complex Karachi), M/o. Interior (Civil Defence Building, Karachi), M/o. Maritime (Marine Academy, Karachi), the AGPR (AGP Office, Karachi) and the Director General Intelligence Bureau (IB Quetta) may provide details and explain reasons for non payment of salaries, salary arrears and other in-service benefits to the PWD Maintenance staff till now.
- (3) The Secretaries of the M/o. of Interior, M/o. Housing and the M/o. Finance may explain reasons for
  - (i) Non-implementation on the Prime Minister's directions dated 13<sup>th</sup> November, 2025 reproduced below (*Ref: PMO. No.2367/SPM/2025 dated 13<sup>th</sup> November, 2025 addressed to the Secretary, M/o. Interior*):
 

"26. The Prime Minister has seen and is pleased to approve the recommendations of the **committee** at para 22 and 23 of the summary, **with the following stipulations:**

**d.** Ministry of Interior and Narcotics Control in consultation with Ministry of Housing & Works and the Ministry of finance shall work out/devise modalities to disburse the claims of the employees including medical charges, advances and pension benefits in a seamless manner and submit a well-defined mechanism with clarity on roles and responsibilities of different stakeholders, **within 15 days** for perusal of the Prime Minister. "
- (4) Chairman CDA, Secretary Finance Division and the AGPR to explain reasons for non-implementation on the Federal Cabinet decision (as notified by the M/o. Housing & Works Notification dated 6<sup>th</sup> Sept. 2024) by not allowing in-service benefits including different types of paid leave, house rent, GP Fund, medical treatment facility/re-imbursment of medical expenses, overtime, grants including marriage, disability, etc. and as well as retirement related benefits including pension, GP Fund, leave encashment, etc.
- (5) The Secretary M/o. Interior and the Chairman CDA may explain reasons for non-implementation on the Wafaqi Mohtasib (Ombudsman)'s recommendations dated

31-3-2026 (issued on 6-4-2026) in Complaint No.WMS-HQR/0001481/26 & 21 Others whereby the Secretary, M/o. Interior was directed

“to issue immediate directions, being the administrative Ministry and Principal Accounting Officer, to CDA and other concerned quarters for expeditious finalization of the pension cases of the complainants, ensuring payment without any further delay.....Compliance be reported within 45 days...”

- (6) The Advisor to honourable Prime Minister and the Secretary Cabinet may attend the meeting to ensure compliance of the Federal Cabinet decision by all concerned as the matter of transfer, payment of in-service and retirement related benefits of PWD Maintenance staff has been under consideration of the Committee since last 10 months whereas the same should have been resolved by all concerned in favour of these employees by 30<sup>th</sup> September, 2024.

[ Para 2(e) of the M/o. Housing & Works Notification dated 6<sup>th</sup> September, 2024 regarding transfer of Maintenance Staff of Pak PWD to CDA, Estate Office and the other Ministries/Divisions/Department of the Federal Government binds the concerned Ministries/Divisions/Departments to complete transfer process of maintenance operations, record and staff by the deadline date of 30<sup>th</sup> Sept. 2024 and this para specifically emphasizes, “.... However, the non-availability of any record shall not delay the transfer of enquiry and staff and it shall be listed as record to be provided.”

Whereas

Para 2 (b) of the Notification safeguards the in-service and post-service benefits of PWD Maintenance Staff by stating “.....Their terms and conditions shall be dealt with in a manner not disadvantageous than the one prescribed in Maintenance Staff Rules-2019 (non statutory), promulgated by the M/o. Housing & Works... ” ]
