Mr. Aftab Ahmed Khan Sherpao: Pakistani Community in Middle East is not facing difficulties now in getting National Identity Cards for Overseas Pakistanis (NICOP) as NADRA has made concrete efforts to resolve the issues pertaining to issuance of identity cards in Middle East. Following steps have been taken by NADRA for issuance of identity cards in time to the Pakistani Community residing in Middle East:—

- (a) To assist National Identity Card for Overseas Pakistanis NADRA Assistants have been employed by the Embassies / Pak Mission. Funds are being provided by NADRA to meet the expenses incurred by the Embassies for promotion of registration of Pakistanis living in Middle East.
- (b) For early process/issuance of cards, NADRA Swift Registration Centres have been established at Jeddah, Saudi Arabia, Establishment of center at Dubai (UAE) is in progress.
- (c) Due to problem in transportation of forms from abroad, arrangements are in hand to receive the real image of forms via Satellite/Fax from the missions abroad.
- (d) The facility of processing passport at the above centers is also in progress and is likely to be completed in next 2-3 weeks.

Rao Sikandar Iqbal: (a) Presently there is no proposal under consideration of Civil Aviation Authority to provide night landing facilities at Quetta Airport.

(b) Quetta Airport has same landing facilities as are available at Peshawar Airport which includes high intensity approach lights, Precision Approach Path Indicator (P API) at both ends of the runway, threshold lights, runway edge lights, strobe lights and taxiway edge lights.

(c) Quetta Airport is located in a valley surrounded by high hills. This offers limited airspace for wide bodied aircraft to manoeuvre, particularly in case of single engine failure or power loss the safety of aircraft and traveling public will be seriously jeopardized. Therefore, in the interest of flight safety, night operations are not recommended. Besides, the passenger traffic is very low.

Now despite that the PIA has been running two flights in a week on this route with Foker 27 Aircraft and whenever there is adequate load and the weather permits, the flight operates otherwise unfortunately it has to be cancelled. (c) Yes. Prescribed passport fee is charged for issuance of official passport to the officers of Senate and National Assembly for the period of their visit abroad

or for minimum validity of one year as the same are issued to facilitate their authorized official visit. Fees charged for passports is not dependent on validity of passports.

This is being used for light traffic by laying RCC slabs over the same. Some of the old slabs have been damaged due to plying of relatively heavier traffic (Tractor Trolleys). The repair of damaged slabs is scheduled to be completed in a fortnight time. However, a causeway adjacent to the Birdge exists for movement of all types of traffic.

Mr. Presiding Officer: Any supplementary?

The Cabinet in its meeting held on March 9, 2005 has constituted a Committee under the Chairmanship of Minister for Interior and comprising Ministers for Foreign Affairs, States and Frontier Regions and Ports and Shipping to devise a forward looking policy in the matter of repatriation of Afghan Refugees after expiry of Tripartite Agreement on March 16, 2006.

Keeping in view the number of remaining Afghans in Pakistan (3.047 million) and the conditions in Afghanistan, no specific date for complete repatriation of all Afghan from Pakistan can be anticipated.

Mr. Presiding Officer: Any supplementary?

With the available clientele one daily train caters for the needs between Peshawar and Quetta.

Presently there is no further proposal under consideration to operate any additional train between Quetta-Peshawar.

- the number of railway engines purchased from abroad from 2000 to 2005 with country-wise break-up;
- whether there is a fact that the said engines were defective, if so, the estimated loss caused to the country due to the import of low quality Railways engines from China;

(c) the authority which initiated and approved the proposal for the said purchase?

Mian Shamim Haider: (a) Pakistan Railways signed one agreement for the procurement of 69 Diesel Electric Locomotives during 2000—2005. These Locomotives have been purchased from China. So far 31 Locomotives have arrived.

(b) These engines were neither defective nor of low quality. The trouble of cracking of underframes was experienced on 10 Locomotives of 3000 Horse Power which were withdrawn from service temporarily. These Locomotives have been attended for strengthening of underframes by the manufacturer free of cost as per warranty clause of contract agreement and are now working satisfactorily.

No such trouble (cracking of underframes) has been experienced on 2000 HP locomotives.

As far as the loss is concerned, it is pointed out that normally Locomotives are withdrawn from service to rectify the teething problems by the manufacturers during the warranty period as per contract agreement. The temporary withdrawal of mentioned Locomotives is proposed to be compensated by the manufacturers by supplying following major assemblies free of cost in addition to repairs/strengthening of underframes:—

Pakistan Broadcastine: Corporation (PBC)..... (Electronic Media)

The concept "Enlightened Moderation" is effectively propagated in Radio programmes such as news, commentaries and discussions regularly. PBC has also introduced programmes for women and youth with emphasis on enlightenment and moderation. Press statements, speeches of President, Prime Minister and Parliamentarians are given prominent coverage with focus on "Enlightened Moderation".

6 remaining Kach Abadis, namely, Tent Colony (G-7/1), 66 Quarters (G-7/2), 48 Quarters (G-7/3), 100 Quarters (F-6/2), France Colony (F-7/4) and Kachi Abadi, G-8/1, comprising 2174 Households are being upgraded at their existing location. Will the Minister for Interior be pleased to state the steps being taken by the Government to prevent human smuggling in the country?

Mr. Aftab Ahmad Khan Sherpao: Human smuggling/trafficking is the burning issue of the day at National and International level and is being addressed by the Government of Pakistan accordingly. Summarily, following measures have been taken to control this menace effectively:—

1. Prevention and Control of Human Trafficking Ordinance (P&CHTO-2002) has been promulgated to meet the National and International requirements for prevention and control of Human Trafficking.
2. Rules under this law have also been approved which for the first time contain provisions for the protection and welfare of the victims of Trafficking, who were earlier treated as co-accused.
3. Emigration Ordinance 1979 and Passport Act, 1974 are being applied extensively to control Human Smuggling on genuine or forged travel documents.
4. An Anti Trafficking Unit, Coordination and Monitoring Cell has been established at FIA HQs Islamabad, with ATUs in all Zonal Directorates of FIA at Karachi, Lahore, Rawalpindi, Peshawar and Quetta, to exclusively deal with the offenses of Human Trafficking.

5. Special training of the Anti Trafficking Units staff of FIA was arranged by US Embassy/International Organization for Migration from 2—13 May 2005 at FIA Academy, Islamabad, to improve the operational capabilities of the investigators of FIA.
6. Presently 08 Passport Circles of FIA are operational through out Pakistan whereas 10 new Circles have been proposed for prompt and effective action against Human Smugglers.
7. Personal Identification Secure Comparison and Evaluation System (PISCES) has been installed at all Immigration Check posts for detection of forgery in travel documents and maintenance of computerized record of incoming and outgoing passengers.
8. Instead of manual Passports, Machine Readable Passports (M1 Ps) have been introduced by the Ministry of Interior to minimize human error in the detection of forgery in travel documents.
9. No exit is allowed to the victims and their smugglers possessing suspected documents. They are referred to Passport Circles for enquiry and legal action.
10. A Help line UAN (111-345-786) has been established in FIA to help the victims and for taking swift action against Human Smugglers/ Trafficking.
11. FIA website (www.fia.org.pk) has been established where complete list of authorized Overseas Employment Promoters and the criminals involved in Human Smuggling and Trafficking has been displayed for the guidance of general public.
12. Meetings, conferences and seminars are being regularly held for better understanding and mutual cooperation on the subject.
13. In view of these steps positive results have been achieved in controlling Human Smuggling/Trafficking which have been acknowledged and appreciated by all concerned, including IOM and State Department of USA. Resultantly, Pakistan now stands removed from the watch list of the Tier-II.
