99. ***Dr. Muhammad Ismail Buledi:** (Notice received on 24-11-2010 at 15:33 p.m.)

Will the Minister for Communications be pleased to state:

- (a) the date of retirement of the incumbent Chairman, NHA; and*
- (b) the criteria laid down for appointment of new Chairman on retirement of incumbent Chairman?*

Dr. Arbab Alamgir Khan: (a) The date of recruitment of Mr. Altaf Ahmed Chaudhty, Chairman NHA from the service of Authority is 30th November, 2010.

(b) Under section 9(1) & (2) of NHA Act 1991, National Highway Council is competent to appoint the Chairman NHA subject to the conditions as determined by the Council.

NHA (Appointment & Promotion) Rules 1995 are silent in respect of BS-21 & above posts, hence the instructions contained in Federal Government Rules are applicable in such case as per Rule 2(3) of the NHA Service Rules 1995.

Will the Minister for Education be pleased to state:

(a) *the percentage of GDP allocated for education sector during the current budget; and*

(b) *whether any change has been made in the said allocation, if so, its details?*

Sardar Aseff Ahmed Ali: (a) The budget allocations for education sector are not made as percentage of Gross Domestic Product (GDP). The value of GDP during a particular year is presented in the Economic Survey, which is published by the Finance Division normally in June (one day before announcement of next year's budget) and only then it becomes possible to determine the value of budget allocations as percentage of GDP in any financial year. However, the budget allocations made for Education by the Federal and Provincial/ Areas Governments during the current financial year 2010-11 are as under:

Will the Minister for Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs be pleased to state whether it is a fact that the Federal Ombudsman has ruled that NEPRA and OGRA will decide the public complaints relating to electricity and gas respectively; if so, its details?

Dr. Zaheeruddin Babar Awan: Yes. It is a fact that Wafaqi Mohtasib Secretariat had decided that NEPRA & OGRA itself shall decide the public complaints relating to Electricity and Gas *w.e.f.* 15th March, 2005 *vide* their D.O. letter, dated 26th February, 2005 and D.O. letter, dated 2nd March, 2005 respectively (Annex-I & II). However, in view of the opinion given by the then Secretary M/o Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs (Annex-III) on a reference from Secretary, Wafaqi Mohtasib Secretariat, (Annex-IV) the Wafaqi Mohtasib Secretariat is now entertaining the complaints of the Electricity and Gas matters *w.e.f.* 20th February, 2007 (Annex-V).

Dr. Arbab Alamgir Khan: (a) Yes, an amount of Rs 576.176 million has been allocated for this project in PSDP 2010-11. An amount of Rs 3.569 million has so far been released. Progress as on Dec. 20, 2010 was as under :—

- b. Right Approach Road : 93.14%
- c. Left Approach Road : 57.05%

Another proposal to establish Quaid-e-Azam National Research Library at Islamabad is also under consideration.

Mr. Hameedullah Jan Afridi: (a) According to the forest assessment conducted by Ministry of Environment in 2004, total area of forests in the country at present is given below:

- (b) i. During the last three years, monitoring has not been conducted at national level. This is a normal practice to conduct national forest assessment after 5-10 years.
- ii. According to the most recent assessment conducted in 2004, average rate of deforestation of natural forests was 27,000 ha per year. Most of this damage was concentrated in Kohistan (Khyber Pakhtunkhwa) and Gilgit-Baltistan.
- iii. A Swiss-funded NGO, Inter-Cooperation, has reported that in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa province, more than 1,07,000 ha of natural forests were removed from 1996 to 2008. WWF have assessed that in Malakand Division (District Swat and Shangl (a), forests on 10,000 ha have been cleared from 2001 to 2009.

Will the Minister for Communications be pleased to state the present status of ongoing projects launched by the National Highways Authority in the Federal Capital and the time by which the work will be completed?

Dr. Arbab Alamgir Khan: No project in Federal Capital is being executed by NHA.

Will the Minister for Social Welfare and Special Education be pleased to state:

- (a) *the names of registered NGOs working in Pakistan indicating also the sources of their income; and*

Ms. Samina Khalid Ghurki: (i) There are 44,000 NGOs, registered under various laws, whose data is available on the “Ministry’s National Database” namely; www.ngoinfo.gov.pk.

(ii) The main sources of NGOs income include fee and charges 50% philanthropy 37%, donor funding 7% and 6% government funding.

(b) Yes, the government is pursuing to bring improvement in the legal framework governing the registration and monitoring of the NGOs and the regulation of flow of foreign funds to the local NGOs. For this purpose, National Assembly Standing Committee on Social Welfare and Special Education has constituted a Sub-committee to review laws relating to governance of the NGOs in the country.
