18. ___***Syeda Sughra Imam:** (Notice received on 26-06-2013 at 09:15 am)

Will the Minister Incharge of the Climate Change Division be pleased to state:

- (a) *the strategy of the Government regarding industrial waste management in the country; and*
- (b) *the steps taken by the Government to ensure implementation of the said strategy?*

Minister Incharge of the Climate Change Division : (a) The industrial waste is being controlled through National Environmental Quality Standards (NEQS) which specify the permissible limits of pollutants (Annex-I). These standards are enforced by the federal and provincial Environmental Protection Agencies (EPAs) in their respective jurisdiction through different rules which spell out sampling and testing procedure and prosecution in the Environmental Tribunals established in each province.

(b) In the post 18th constitutional amendment, Provincial departments are responsible to implement the environmental laws. The Climate Change Division has, however taken the following steps:

- i. Delegated powers for enforcement of the Environmental Protection Act 1997 to the provincial governments including the powers to monitor and prosecute industry for violation of the law.
- ii. Notified sampling Rules 2001.
- iii. Notified pollution charge for Industry Rules 2001.

47. ___***Haji Muhammad Adeel:** (Notice received on 22-07-2013 at 11:55 am)

Will the Minister Incharge of the Cabinet Division be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that land mafia is purchasing land in sector, G-12, Islamabad, through non registered stamp papers and carrying out haphazard construction thereon without approval of the competent authority, if so, the action taken by CDA in this regard; and
- (b) the time by which CDA will take possession of land in the said sector and develop it?

Minister Incharge of the Cabinet Division : (a) There are reports of certain elements carrying out such illegal activity on CDA's acquired land in G-12. Some locals have also constructed rooms and new houses in G-12 on the plea that the CDA award has not been accepted by them and they are in Court against it. As far as CDA is concerned, no approval has been given by CDA to these constructions. Directorate of Enforcement is chalking out a plan for a coordinated effort to remove the illegal encroachers with police and ICT.

(b) CDA is planning to vacate this sector at the earliest. However, as the land matters take time so it is not possible to give an exact date. However, it is planned to get it vacated in the next 12 months beginning from G-12/1 and G-12/2 first where encroachment is minimal. After vacation development work will begin.

117. ***Haji Mohammad Adeel:** (Notice received on 23-07-2013 at 10:15 am)

Will the Minister Incharge of the Cabinet Division be pleased to state:

- (a) *the period during which CDA received applications for allotment of plots in sector E-12, Islamabad;*
- (b) *the number of allottees in the said sector who have died and their plots transferred to their legal heirs; and*
- (c) *the time by which the said sector will be developed and possession of plots handed over to the allottees?*

Minister Incharge of the Cabinet Division : (a) The period involved for receiving of application is 25-04-1989 to 15-06-1989.

(b) Out of 4430 allottees of Plots approximately 443 allottees have died and their plots were transferred in the names of legal heirs.

(c) Efforts are being made to develop the sector. Tender for Roads have been given. The pending claims of original owners are being settled.

118. ***Haji Mohammad Adeel:** (Notice received on 23-07-2013 at 10:15 am)

Will the Minister Incharge of the Cabinet Division be pleased to state:

- (a) *the period during which CDA received applications for allotment of plots in sector I-15, Islamabad;*
- (b) *the number of allottees in the said sector who have died and their plots transferred to their legal heirs; and*
- (c) *the time by which the said sector will be developed and possession of plots handed over to the allottees?*

Minister Incharge of the Cabinet Division : (a) Applications for allotment of plots in Sector I-15 were received during 25-7-2005 to 10-9-2005

(b) Out of 9000 allottees of Plots & flats, Approximately 267 allottees have died and theirs plots & flats were transferred in the name of legal heirs.

(c) CDA Board has now decided to abolish the vertical developments & opted for horizontal development. Hence, CDA has initiated revision of layout plan & other infrastructure work. After

designing and allocation of fund, the work will be taken up in hand within 03 months and will be completed in 03 years.

120. ___*Mrs. Sehar Kamran : (Notice received on 13-08-2013 at 11:25 am)

Will the Minister Incharge of the Aviation Division be pleased to state the steps being taken by the Government to upgrade the small airports in the country and to improve facilities on those airports?

Minister Incharge of the Aviation Division : There are 42 civil airports in the country, out of which 27 airports are operational and 15 have been scaled down due to discontinuation of PIAC Operation and insufficient traffic load. CAA has been making efforts to upgrade the small airports in the country and to improve their available facilities, for which they have allocated an amount of Rs.522.118 million in their Annual Development Programme (ADP), 2013-14.

111. ___*Mr. Baz Muhammad Khan : (Notice received on 30-08-2013 at 01:15 pm)

Will the Minister Incharge of the Cabinet Division be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that a time limit / period has been prescribed for making construction on residential and commercial plots allotted by CDA in Islamabad;*
- (b) the number of plots in Islamabad on which construction has not been made so far despite expiry of the said limit /period with sector-wise breakup and the details of action taken against the allottees concerned;*
- (c) the amount of fine imposed on the said allottees and the amount recovered out of the same so far;*
- (d) the number of the said cases in which extension in that period has been granted indicating also the reasons for extension; and*
- (e) the number of the said cases in which allotments have been canceled?*

Minister Incharge of the Cabinet Division : The information is being collected from the quarter concerned it will be placed before the House as and when received.

112. ___*Mr. Saleem H. Mandviwalla: (Notice received on 30-08-2013 at 01:15 pm)

Will the Minister Incharge of the Aviation Division be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that while appointing Mr. Shujaat Azeem as Advisor to the Prime Minister on Aviation, his Court Marshal (Disciplinary action), dual nationality and the conflict of interest was overlooked, if so, the reasons thereof;*
- (b) whether it is also a fact that the said Advisor made a presentation to ECC, if so, the capacity in which he made the presentation; and*

(c) *whether it is further a fact that the said Advisor passed directive/ orders in writing such as promotion of employees, notice for vacation of PIA building, use of generators and shifting of CAA and ASF in PIA building, if so, the capacity in which same were passed?*

Minister Incharge of the Aviation Division : (a) Not concerned to Aviation Division.

(b) The former advisor to the Prime Minister on Aviation matters made the presentation in a special meeting of ECC on PIAC as the Advisor to the Prime Minister on Aviation was with a status of Federal Minister notified by Notification No. 3-3/2013-Min-I dated 7th June, 2013.

(c) No such direction was passed by the Ex. Adviser on Aviation, however, his status was that of a Federal Minister.

113. ___***Mr. Hamza** : (Notice received on 30-08-2013 at 02:50 pm)

Will the Minister Incharge of the Aviation Division be pleased to state whether it is a fact that the Karachi-Lahore bounded PIA flight No.PK-302 was delayed for two hours on 17th July, 2013, if so, its reasons?

Minister Incharge of the Aviation Division : No delay was involved for departure of PK-302 on 17th July, 2013 as the same was operated on scheduled time.

114. ___***Sardar Muhammad Yaqoob Khan Nasir**: (Notice received on 30-08-2013 at 04:00 pm)

Will the Minister Incharge of the Aviation Division be pleased to state:

(a) *whether it is a fact that Jumbo, A.P, B.F. W (B-747) aeroplane of PIA has recently been auctioned, if so, the price at which the same was purchased and the price at which it has been sold / auctioned;*

(b) *the procedure adopted for auctioning of the said aeroplane;*

(c) *whether there is any proposal under consideration of the Government to auction more PIA aeroplanes, if so, the number thereof and*

(d) *whether there is any proposal under consideration of the Government to purchase new aircrafts for PIA, if so, the number thereof?*

Minister Incharge of the Aviation Division : (a) Yes, the said aircraft was auctioned after proper cannibalization of serviceable components, “as is where is” basis through publication of advertisement in print/electronic media. The same was purchased at the price of USD 10 (ten) million (import value) in the year, 2002 and sold against the reserve price of 6.8 million.

(b) Open public auction through Government Auctioneer.

(c) Presently, no proposal for the auction of more PIA aeroplane is under consideration.

(d) There is no proposal under consideration of PIA to purchase/acquire new aircraft.

115. ___***Haji Mohammad Adeel:**(Notice received on 02-09-2013 at 11:10 am)

Will the Minister Incharge of the Cabinet Division be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that CDA has not prepared and enforced any master plan for zone-IV, Islamabad, so far;*
- (b) whether it is also a fact that haphazard development is being carried out by several housing societies and departments in the said zone; and*
- (c) the time by which a master plan for the said zone will be prepared and enforced?*

Minister Incharge of the Cabinet Division : (a) Yes it is fact that CDA has not prepared any master Plan for Zone-4 of Islamabad. The Zone-4 of Islamabad was regulated as per provisions of Islamabad Zoning Regulation 1992, which was approved by the Federal Government in the year 1992. In the year 2010 the amendment in ICT Zoning Regulation 1992 were presented before the Federal Cabinet through Summary and presentation, which were approved by the Federal Cabinet for Zone-4 of Islamabad. Since then CDA has been enforcing planning and development provisions as per amendments for Zone-4 of Islamabad made in the year 2010 in ICT Zoning Regulation 1992.

As per provisions of Amendment in ICT Zoning Regulation 1992, Zone-4 has been sub divided in four sub zones to regulate the land use plan of these sub zones.

(b) Yes there are land subdivisions without approval of planning and NOC for development by CDA. CDA has issued notices to such developers to refrain from illegal land sub divisions. Similarly CDA has also sensitized the general public to refrain from purchasing in these illegal housing societies.

(c) CDA has decided to prepare Master Plan for Zone 4 and 5 of Islamabad. The process to hire the services of consultants for preparation of Master Plan will be initiated accordingly. The exact time frame for preparation of Master Plan can not be specified, however.

116. ___***Haji Mohammad Adeel:** (Notice received on 02-09-2013 at 11:10 am)

Will the Minister Incharge of the Cabinet Division be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that CDA has constructed Ibn-e-Sina Road touching Sectors G-8, G-9, G-10, G-11 and the Federal Government Employees Housing Foundation has constructed Ibn-e-Sina Road touching Sectors G-13 and G-14, Islamabad; and*
- (b) whether it is also a fact that CDA has not constructed Ibn-e-Sina Road touching Sector G-12, Islamabad, as provided in the master plan, if so, the time by which the same will be constructed?*

Minister Incharge of the Cabinet Division : (a) Capital Development Authority as per provision of the Master Plan of Islamabad has constructed Ibn-e-Sina road from Sector G-8 to G-11, Construction of road from G-13 to G-14 pertains to Federal Government Employees Housing Foundation. CDA has constructed the roads in G-13 as deposit work. But sector G-14 is being developed by the Federal Government Housing Foundations. Hence responsibility for construction of Road in the alignment of Ibn-e-Sina Road in G-14 rests with Federal Government Housing Foundation.

(b) CDA could not take up work on Ibn-e-Sina road in G-12 due to non-availability of possession. Time cannot be specified because work on Road can be taken up on availability of possession.

Will the Minister for Commerce and Textile Industry be pleased to state:

(a) *the details of investment presently made by the State Life Insurance Corporation of Pakistan;*

(c) *the name/names of authority which granted approval for that investment?*

Will the Minister Incharge of the Aviation Division be pleased to state:

- (a) *whether it is a fact that fine has been imposed on PIA by a number of countries for carrying passengers on faulty / fake documents, if so, the details thereof since 1st January, 2011; and*
- (b) *whether it is also a fact that PIA has not evolved an integrated system to curb such practices by taking all institutions of the Government on board, if so, the steps being taken to evolve such system?*

Minister Incharge of the Aviation Division : (a) Yes. The following fines have been imposed on PIAC by number of countries for carrying passengers on faulty/fake documents:—

(b) The PIAC has already evolved an integrated system in-collaboration with Aviation Division and other stakeholders in a meeting held on 6th December 2010 in Ministry of Defence to minimize the travel of inadmissible passengers. The policy is paying the dividends.

120. ___*Col. (R) Syed Tahir Hussain Mashhadi: (Notice received on 05-09-2013 at 09:30 am).

Will the Minister Incharge of the Aviation Division be pleased to state:

- (a) *the profit earned or loss suffered by PIA from its flights on Karachi-Frankfurt-Copenhagen sector during the last three years with month-wise break-up; and*
- (b) *whether it is a fact that PIA is suffering loss-on the said sector, if so, the reasons for not discontinuing its operation on that sector?*

Minister Incharge of the Aviation Division : (a) PIA is operating twice weekly flights to Copenhagen/Oslo route with B777 aircraft on Lahore-Oslo-Copenhagen-Lahore and Islamabad-Copenhagen-Oslo-Islamabad. Following profit has been generated during the last three years:—

(b) PIA had operated twice weekly flights on Frankfurt/Amsterdam route with A310 aircraft on Lahore-Frankfurt-Amsterdam-Islamabad and Islamabad-Amsterdam-Frankfurt-Lahore and incurred following loss: —

Due to heavy losses on the above route, PIA does not have any option left but to close the route effective September 07, 2013. The suspension of the route is the part of overall route restructuring.

Will the Minister Incharge of the Capital Administration and Development Division be pleased to refer to Senate starred Question No.34 replied on 22nd August, 2013 and state:

- (a) *whether it is a fact that the students of F. G. Junior Model Schools (renamed as Islamabad Model Schools) who got scholarships in the centralized examination of class-V during the years 2011 and 2012 have not been paid the amount of scholarships so far despite the assurance given in reply to the referred question, if so, its reasons; and*
- (b) *the time by which payment of amount of scholarships will be made to the said students?*

Minister Incharge of the Capital Administration and Development Division : (a) The students of Islamabad Model Schools (former F.G Junior Model Schools) who were awarded scholarships in the Centralized Examination of Class-V have been paid as per following detail:—

Minister Incharge of the Cabinet Division : (a) The Federal Minister/ Minister of State / Advisor / Special Assistant to the Prime Minister with the status of Minister / Minister of State, are entitled to use one 1800cc Staff Car for official use, as per Rule 3 (2) (**Annex-I**) and 24 (2)(a), under the Rules for use of Staff Cars, 1980 (**Annex-II**).

(b) The respective Ministries / Divisions are responsible to provide Staff Cars to their Federal Minister / Minister of state / Advisor to the Prime Minister / Parliamentary Secretaries allocated portfolio, under the Rule 24 (4)(a)(b), Rules for use of Staff Cars, 1980 (**Annex-II**).

However, Cabinet Division is responsible to provide Staff Cars to Advisor / Special Assistant to the Prime Minister without portfolio. As per Rule 24(4) (c) of above said Rules. The Cabinet Division has allocated two 1800 cc vehicles to the following SAsPM (without portfolio):-

- (a) *whether it is a fact that CDA has recently cancelled some plots in Jinnah Super Market, Islamabad, if so, the details thereof indicating also the date of allotment, name of allottee, price and purpose of allotment in each case; and*
- (b) *the name of authority which approved the allotment of the said plots?*

Minister Incharge of the Cabinet Division : (a) No plot has been cancelled recently. However, Tea Stall No. 23, Markaz F-7, Islamabad measuring 21-3/9 Sq.yds was cancelled on 16-04-2012. The plot was allotted @Rs. 12,650/- per sq.yd which comes to Rs. 2,69,824/50. Tea stall plot was allotted to Mr. Mahmood Saeed on 08-10-1998.

The plot was cancelled due to violation of building bye-laws and encroachment on CDA land. Cancellation was approved by the Chairman, CDA being competent authority in the matter.

- (b) CDA Board approved the auction.

126. ***Syeda Sughra Imam:**(Notice received on 09-09-2013 at 09:20 am)

Will the Minister for National Food Security and Research be pleased to state the steps taken by the Government to regulate poultry production in the country in order to meet international nutritional standards?

Mr. Skandar Hayat Khan Bosan : Poultry production is a private sector activity. **Government at its end is supportive of the private sector led development of poultry industry.** The livestock products including poultry are regulated by the West Pakistan Pure Food Ordinance, 1960.

In order to ensure nutritional standards in the poultry products, the use of balance poultry ration during poultry production is very important. Govt has taken following regulatory measures in order to meet international nutritional standards in poultry production:

- * The import duty on poultry feed additives, growth promoters premixes, vitamin premixes has been zero rated to encourage the use of balanced ration in poultry feeding.
- * To ensure maximum nutrition and quality of poultry feed the import of Zinc sulphate, Copper sulphate and coccidiostat have also been allowed at zero custom duty.

The above steps have improved feed efficiency in poultry farming in terms of feed conversion ratio, production of day old chicks / eggs / meat and nutritional value of their products.

Will the Minister for National Food Security and Research be pleased to state whether there is any proposal under consideration of the Government to import wheat during the current financial year, if so, its details?

Mr. Skandar Hayat Khan Bosan : There is no proposal under consideration of the Government to import wheat during current financial year. However, there is no ban on import of wheat by the private sector.

The Institutions performing functions or rendering services within the territorial limits of ICT are placed under the Capital Administration and Development Division. Whereas, institutions performing functions or rendering services involving linkages with entities beyond the territorial jurisdiction of ICT, i.e. Provinces or International Institutions / Agencies etc. are placed under the relevant Ministries / Divisions.

(b) The matter was placed before the Secretaries' Committee in its meeting held on 5th September, 2013. The Committee after consideration has not recommended to transfer the administrative control of Federal Board of Intermediate and Secondary Education from Ministry of Education, Trainings and Standards in Higher Education to the Capital Administration and Development Division. The recommendations of the Secretaries' Committee were also based on the grounds as mentioned at (a) above.
