**Chaudhry Nisar Ali Khan:** (a) 2 x vehicles (GW-768 Land Cruiser, GU-539 Toyota Hilux) owned by NADRA are being used since June 2010. Detail of expenditure incurred on POL and maintenance are at **Annex-A**.

(b) The name of NADRA employees presently attached with the Ministry of Interior indicating date of attachment in each case is attached as **Annex-B**. They are in process of repatriation to their parent department as per the decision of the Minister of Interior.

78. **\*Haji Mohammad Adeel:** (Notice received on 30-12-2013 at 12:05 pm)

*Will the Minister for Information, Broadcasting and National Heritage be pleased to state:*

- (a) *the sources of income of the Pakistan National Council of the Arts;*

**Mr. Pervaiz Rashid:** (a) As per-Section 8 of the PNCA Act. 1973, the fund of the Council shall be derived from the following sources;

1. Grants of the Federal Government and the Provincial Governments; and
  2. Contributions and donations from individuals, local bodies, corporations, institutions, organizations and agencies;
- (b) As per Section 7 of the PNCA Act, the Council shall:—
- (1) Advise the Federal Government on matters of policy on artistic activity and their implementation;
  - (2) Improve knowledge, understanding and practice of the arts and advise the Federal Government in order to increase regional activity through systematic planning and co-ordination at all levels;
  - (3) Co-ordinate, evaluate and supervise activities of cultural organizations and individuals engaged in cultural activities;
  - (4) Advise and assist the Provincial Governments in setting up of Provincial Arts Councils to serve as liaison between the local cultural bodies and the Council with regard to their activities and financial assistance;
  - (5) Plan, establish and run art academies, folk museums, exhibition halls, auditoria, art galleries and similar other institutions;
  - (6) Organize exhibitions of arts and crafts within the country and abroad;
  - (7) Organize national and regional ensembles for performance within the country and abroad;
  - (8) Organize and promote cultural fairs and-festivals;
  - (9) Help, establish and organize national unions of artistes on the basis of their chosen field of activity;

- (10) Help in the implementation of cultural pacts and programmes on directions of the Federal Government;
  - (11) Have contacts with similar organizations in other countries, through the Federal Government;
  - (12) Set up panels of experts in specific fields of the arts where necessary; and
  - (13) Perform any other function in the field of arts which the Federal Government may direct or which the Council may consider necessary or desirable.

*Will the Minister for Railways be pleased to state:*

- (a) *whether it is a fact that track and some other belongings of Pakistan Railways have been stolen from the sections which have been closed down, if so, the details thereof; and*
- (b) *the steps taken by the Government for the safety of tracks and other items on those tracks?*

**Khawaja Saad Rafique:** (a) It is a fact that some track material has been stolen from various closed sections of Pakistan Railways in the past. Details about theft of track is attached as Annexure-A.

(b) The steps taken for the safety of tracks and other items on closed sections are as under:

- (i) In the past, Railway assets on the closed sections were being watched by the un-armed gang men /patrollers, which did not provide the required protection to the assets on closed sections. Now it has been decided to safeguard above assets through armed Police Personnel.
- (ii) A large number of FIRs have been registered to trace/arrest the miscreants. Material amounting more than Rs.9.00 million has been recovered during recent past.
- (iii) In addition a high level Committee has been constituted to conduct a survey to ascertain the commercial viability of the closed sections so as the same may be opened for traffic and assets on rest of the sections may be disposed off.

80. **\*Mr. Muhammad Talha Mehmood:** (Notice received on 01-01-2014 at 09:00 am)

*Will the Minister for Railways be pleased to state:*

**Khawaja Saad Rafique:** (a) At present following Railways sections are closed for the traffic being loss making sections.

(b) Immediate restoration of these closed sections is not on the card. Firstly Pakistan Railway is focusing to improve the quality of services given to 96/ running Passenger trains. After creating a balance between passenger & freight trains, Pakistan Railways would try to open-up these closed section.

**Mr. Pervaiz Rashid:** There are following six Archaeological sites/monuments of Pakistan included in the World Heritage List of UNESCO :—

- (i) Archaeological Ruins at Moenjodaro

- (ii) Archaeological Ruins at Taxila
- (iii) Buddhist Ruins at Takht-e-Bahi and neighboring city at Sehr-e-Behlol, Mardan
- (iv) Historical Monuments at Makli, Thatta
- (v) Fort and Shalamar Garden, Lahore
- (vi) Rohtas Fort, Jhelum

No site/monument of Pakistan as mentioned above has been delisted /removed from UNESCO World Heritage List since 1988.

**Khawaja Saad Rafique:** (a) The present liabilities of Pakistan Railways under various categories as on 30th June, 2013 appearing in the draft Annual Financial Statement are provided hereunder:—

(b) The assets appearing in the balance sheet are recorded on historical basis *i.e* cost at the time of acquisition of assets. The liabilities of Pakistan Railways are annually assessed as on June 30.

(c) The liabilities towards employees and contractors are cleared as and when these become due for payment. However, the liabilities towards the Economic Affairs Division on account of relent foreign loans and State Bank of Pakistan in the form of overdraft will be cleared as and when Pakistan Railways will have adequate fiscal space.

(b) The crime trend during the last six years *i.e.* since 2008, is as under:

- i. Cases regarding kidnapping for ransom and robberies have been decreased by 4.45% and 1.85% (average) respectively.
- ii. Cases regarding gang rape have been increased by 1.1%, (average).

**Khawaja Saad Rafique** (a) The existing last Audit Report is in respect of the accounts of financial year 2011-12.

(b) The Auditor General of Pakistan has made 73 Audit Observations under the following categories in its last Audit Report on Railways accounts (financial year 2011-12).

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#### 4. Others

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The Audit Report has yet not been taken up by the Public Accounts Committee for discussion. The Departmental Accounts Committee (DAC) has met on 02nd & 03rd December, 2013 and discussed 41 Audit Paras out of 73 Audit Paras of the relevant Report. The DAC noted that 7 cases of irregularities are being investigated/tried by NAB, FIA and courts respectively and the outcome is awaited.

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The next meeting of DAC is likely to be held in March 2014, which will monitor compliance to the recommendations of DAC and review the remaining 32 Audit paras.

88. **\*Syeda Sughra Imam:** (Notice received on 08-01-2014 at 12:45 pm)

*Will the Minister for Interior and Narcotics Control be pleased to state whether it is a fact that some seminaries / madrasahs in the country are receiving financial and other support like training of clerics, teachers, curriculum development etc. from some foreign Islamic countries, if so, the details thereof?*

**Chaudhry Nisar Ali Khan:** Ministry of Interior has been issuing NOC to 14 Universities/NGO's/charitable Foundations during last five years for obtaining financial assistance from abroad/Islamic Countries through Ministry of Foreign Affairs (Annex-I). However, financial assistance for religious/sectarian purposes is always discouraged as the same is potential threat to volatile Law & order situation and sectarian harmony in the country.

*Will the Minister for Information, Broadcasting and National Heritage be pleased to state:*

- (a) whether it is a fact that new medium wave transmitter for Radio Pakistan Hyderabad has been received, if so, the date on which the same was received;*
- (b) whether it is also a fact that the said transmitter has not been installed so far, if so, its reasons and the time by which the same will be installed; and*
- (c) the details of work completed in connection with installation of that transmitter so far?*

**Mr. Pervaiz Rashid:** (a) A 100 KW Medium Wave Transmitter has been received and installed at Hyderabad on 15-02-2013.

(b) All the installation work of Transmitter, allied equipment and repair work has been completed.

(c) Renovation of building, installation of transmitter & allied equipments, Antenna tuning unit, Feeder line, scraping & painting of 420 Ft mast, installation of A/C plant have been completed and the transmitter will be ready for commissioning in the 2nd week of March, 2014.

**Mr. Pervaiz Rashid:** (a) Pakistan National Council of the Arts organized several cultural programs in which artists from FATA were invited to showcase and promote their art and culture at the national stage. List of events in which artists from FATA participated is placed at **Annex-I**. Besides this financial assistance in shape of free provision of PNCA Auditorium was provided

to an Organizer of KPK for thirteen (13) cultural programs (list **Annex-II**), in which artists from KPK/ FATA performed. Payment to artists was made by the organizer.

Lok Virsa promotes and documents the rich culture of Pakistan which includes all the regions irrespective of religion, cast, ethnic, groups etc. We have document the culture of KPK including FATA & PATA areas. However occasionally we have invited and documented the ATTAN dance which particularly belongs to tribal area.

(b) The names of artists belonging to FATA who were invited by Pakistan National Council of the Arts along with remuneration paid to each artist during the last five years is placed at **Annex-III**.

(c) Nil report.

**Mr. Pervaiz Rashid:** (a) The artists are paid remuneration for their performances in the programs arranged by the Pakistan National Council of the Arts according to the requirement of the program. Detail of remuneration paid to artists during the last one year is placed at **Annex-I**.

(b) Remuneration to artists is based on the artistic excellence, experience of artist, recognition and popularity in the field, requirement of the program and length of performance. Keeping in to consideration the above factors, the remuneration is approved by the Director General on the recommendation of concerned specialist Division of the PNCA.

(c) There is no disparity in remuneration to artists on the basis of region./ province to which the artists hails but the factors explained in Part-b of the question are kept into consideration while determining remuneration of artists. Artists from all regions of the country are looked as Artists of Pakistan and are not discriminated on the basis of region. Detail of payments made to artists belonging to different provinces during last one year (2012-13) is placed at Annex-I. In collaboration with an organizer, PNCA arranged 13 programs promoting artists of KPK/FATA. Payments were made to the artists by the organizer, PNCA provided its Auditorium free of cost. List of program attached at **Annex-II**.
