RESOLUTION NO.490

“Recognizing Pakistan's commitment in fulfilling Sustainable Development Goal-5 encompassing a continued commitment to achieve gender equality as state's responsibility to “ensure” women's full and effective participation and equal opportunities for leadership at all levels of decision-making in political, economic and public life;

Cognizant of the fact that women constitute half of our population share but despite that their share in decision-making and senior positions level and leadership is small and shows no clear trend toward improvement;

This House recommends that the Government should initiate a review process through all Ministries in order to ascertain the following areas:

a) To update the ratio of female officers at senior positions in all the Government entities and institutions;

b) To identify the gaps in gender inequality at senior level positions indicating also the reasons of the lower number of female officers thereof;

This House further recommends that on the basis of the review action conducted by the relevant quarters the Government should take immediate measures to increase the number of women officers at decision making positions and ensure their meaningful representation at all levels in the Federal Government entities / institutions.”

RESOLUTION NO.491

“This House expresses its grave concerns over the improper, unjustified and inequitable credit/lending by the commercial banks in the small provinces of the country especially Balochistan and Khyber Pakhtunkhwa which are leading to deprivation, disparity and slow progress of industrialization and commercial activities in those provinces.

This House strongly demands the Government to take immediate and result oriented steps to ensure that the minimum credit/lending of the commercial banks to the private sector for establishing industry and commercial activities in the provinces of Balochistan and Khyber Pakhtunkhwa is at par with those provinces' total deposits in the banks.

This House also recommends the Government either to introduce a new legislation or amend the present laws/regulations in that regard.”
