



## **RESOLUTION NO.519**

### **"The Senate of Pakistan:**

while acknowledging " **Gender equality today for a sustainable tomorrow**": as a theme for International Women`s Day, commends the efforts of women and girls around the world, who are leading the charge on climate change adaptation, mitigation, and response to build a more sustainable future for all;

**Acknowledges** that women and girls are effective and powerful leaders and change-makers for climate adaptation and mitigation due to their involvement in the sustainability initiatives around the world;

**Appreciates** that the barriers are removed by the parliament and Government of Pakistan to create linkages between gender, the environment and sustainable development; and

**Recommends** that the Government should take initiatives to empower women and girls to have a voice and be equal players in decision -making related to climate change and sustainability".
